- o 2 years
 - o AP Seminar – Grade 11
 - o AP Research – Grade 12 (for students who took AP Seminar)
- o Passing both = AP Seminar & Research Certificate
- o Passing both + 4 other AP exams = AP Capstone Diploma

- Full time PCS Counselor on site
- Students earn AA degree upon completion

Early Admissions Program

- Begins in 12th grade
- State testing requirements, Geometry, World History & HOPE must be complete to apply
- Application deadline 2/10/2016
- 40 seniors per campus
- Clearwater, Gibbs, Seminole, Tarpon Springs
- Some students may earn AA degree upon completion
