

World History Summer Assignments

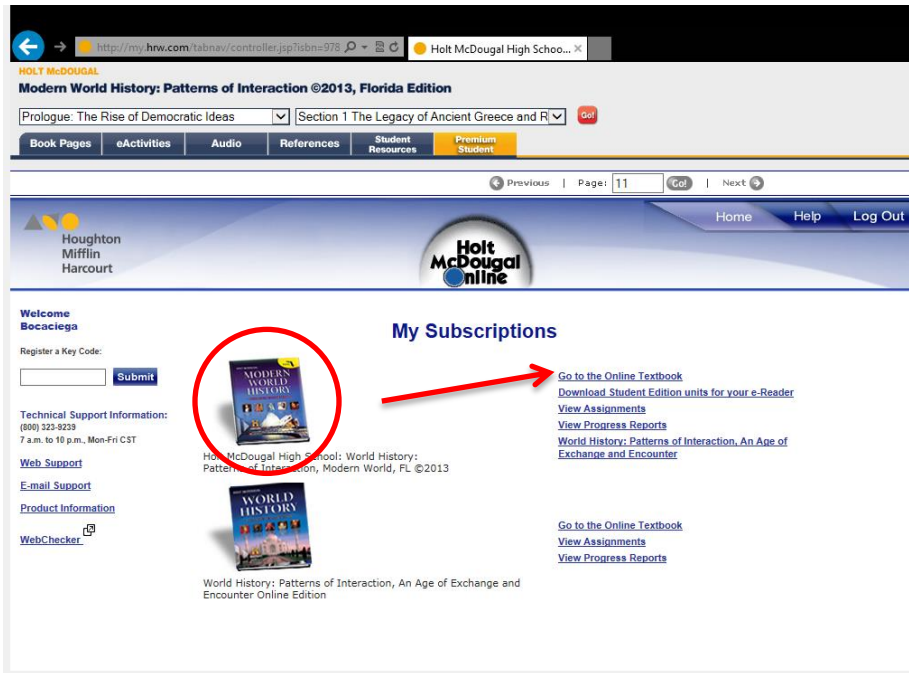


Students must complete these three assignments before the start of their 2015-2016 school year. School resumes on August 24th for students.

How to access the online textbook: First, visit <http://my.hrw.com> and enter the password: bocaciega and username: bocaciega. Click Log In. (see below)

Assignments

1. Prologue Reading

Assignment: Read pages 5 -29 of the Prologue.

Directions: Use the down box that says “select a unit or chapter” and choose “Prologue: The Rise of Democratic Ideas”. On the second drop down box select “Section 1” and click the red Go button. Use the grey “next” and “previous” buttons to navigate between pages.

2. Prologue Vocabulary Cards

Assignment: Use index cards to create a flash card for each of the 30 vocabulary words found in the Prologue.

Directions: The vocabulary words are listed on the first page of each section under “Terms and Names”. Place the word on one side of the card and the appropriate definition on the other. Use the definitions provided by the glossary which can be found by clicking on the blue “Resources” tab at the top of the web page.

3. Know the Continents and Oceans

Assignment: Be prepared to take a quiz the first week back to school on the continents and oceans. You must be able to identify their location on a map and explain where they are in relation to one another. To do this, be prepared to locate the equator, the prime meridian, and the four cardinal directions.

Directions: Use pages A2 and A3 of the online textbook or another world map of your choice to learn the location of the 5 oceans (Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Arctic Ocean, Southern Ocean, Indian Ocean) and 7 continents (North America, South America, Africa, Europe, Asia, Australia, Antarctica)
