# TARDY PROCESS

- **PERIODS 1 & 2** – Report to class as quickly as possible. Frequent tardiness to school will result in administration referral

# DRESS FOR SUCCESS PLAN

- ADDITIONALLY
- Leotard/spandex including sport bras **CANNOT** be worn

- No Hats or head coverings – except for P.E. activities
- No sunglasses may be worn inside without doctor's note
- No bandanas or sweatbands

# ELECTRONICS POLICY

THE CLASSROOM IS THE INSTRUCTOR'S DOMAIN. IF THE TEACHER DOES NOT ALLOW ELECTRONICS OF ANY KIND TO BE OUT OR USED IN THEIR CLASS ROOM – OR REQUESTS THAT A STUDENT PUT AWAY THEIR ELECTRONICS - THE STUDENT MUST COMPLY WITH THE REQUEST. **FAILURE TO DO SO – WILL RESULT IN A DEFIANCE REFERRAL**

- 2.0 Unweighted Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Pass Florida Standards Assessment for English/Writing
- Pass Algebra 1 End of Course Exam (other EOCs count as 30% of final grade)
