

Congratulations on being the parent of a Senior!

Senior year is a special time, both for students and their family. As a senior parent you have the opportunity to give a special gift that will last a lifetime. Senior Dedications are a great way to share your memories of your students' school years and celebrate their graduation. We have several options for your special message and photographs. Prices are based on production costs and all funds help to keep down the cost of your yearbook.

The **deadline** for placing a Senior Dedication is **Monday, February 1st, 2015**.

Step 1: Choose a Size

Ad Size	Measurements	Price
Full Page	8.5" x 11.5"	\$300
Half Page	8.5" x 5.5"	\$160
Quarter Page	4.18" x 5.5"	\$100
Eighth Page	4.18" x 2.75"	\$60

Remember these prices do NOT include a yearbook! Yearbooks can be purchased online at balfour.com or at the school with cash or check. Yearbook prices are:

Step 2: Prepare your message and photos OR design your own ad

We have a skilled Ad Designer on staff ready to design your Ad. She will work with you to choose fonts and crop photos to make your ad look its best. Please see the back of these letter for the design contract which gives guidelines on how much text and how many pictures will fit on each size of ad.

If you plan on designing your own ad, please make sure it fits in the measurements listed above. Check out past yearbooks and the attachments to this letter for design examples.

Step 3: Send us your stuff

Send orders with your message and photos by one of two ways:

1. Email pettingilld@pcsb.org. Please include all of the information from the order form as well as your text and photos. If you have multiple photos you may need to send them in separate emails. A confirmation will be sent that it was received – if you do not receive a confirmation then it was not received! Then you can bring payment by the school (attn.: Ms. Pettingill) or pay online at balfour.com. Either way please note with the payment that you have emailed your information.
2. Drop off your text, photos, design contract and check to the front office. Attn: Ms. Pettingill.
3. Make an appointment to meet with our Ad Designer, Brooke Gainey. Our yearbook class is 4th period (9:46am -10:31am.) Other times can be arranged to meet as well.

NOTE: Please send high resolution photos. No photocopies or Facebook pictures please – they look terrible reproduced. If you need us to scan your originals we highly recommend that you make an appointment and we will scan them and give them back to you so there is no chance of important family photos being misplaced. Or scan your pictures & email them or bring them in on CD or a flash drive.

The amount of text designated here is a guideline; the amount that will fit will depend on the font type and size chosen. You can draw how you would like the ad to look on the back of this page.
