PROGRAMS AT THE CLEARWATER CAMPUS



Accounting Operations* 10.5 Month Program

Prepare for a career in a financial business environment. Training in Peachtree, QuickBooks, and related software will be used to enhance workplace productivity. Tuition **\$2,628**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,228

Administrative Office Specialist* 12 Month Program

Prepare for employment as administrative assistants and office managers. Courses include: Information Technology Assistant, Front Desk Specialist, Assistant Digital Production Designer and Administrative Assistant.

Tuition **\$3,066**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,365

Applied Information Technology* 7 Month Program

The Applied Information Technology Program offers a broad foundation of technical knowledge and computer skills to prepare students for employment as a Computer Support Technician. Upon completion of this program, students will have computer applications skills including computer hardware, Microsoft Office applications, web applications, network concepts, and relational database skills.

Applied Welding Technologies 13.5 Month Program

Automotive Service Technology 24 Month Program

Cabinetmaking 13.5 Month Program

Phlebotomy* 3.5 Month Program

Train to collect and transport laboratory specimens, and record patient data, to facilitate the administration of blood transfusions and lab testing while gaining the skills and knowledge to become a Registered Phlebotomy Technician – RPT.

Practical Nursing* 15.5 Month Program

Train in the administration of treatments and medication in the care of the ill while gaining the skills and knowledge to successfully pass the State Licensing Exam and become a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

School Age Certification Training* 120 Hour Program

Students will understand and demonstrate the following elements of the child care industry: physical and intellectual competence, family involvement, developmentally appropriate practices for school age children, and program management.

Web Development* 12 Month Program

PROGRAMS AT THE ST. PETERSBURG CAMPUS



Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, & Heating Technology 9 Month Program

Training includes the study of principles of heating and air conditioning, soldering, electricity, controllers, troubleshooting, fabrication, and specialty equipment maintenance and repair.

Tuition **\$2,190**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$2,564

Applied Welding Technologies 13.5 Month Program

Prepare for certification and employment as a welder in the fabrication and repair industry, as well as the construction industry, using shielded metal arc (stick), shielded gas arc (TIG), plasma arc (MIG) and pipe welding techniques.

Tuition **\$3,416**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$2,300

Automotive Collision Repair & Refinishing 18 Month Program

Courses cover estimating and evaluating body damage, inspection, measuring, repairing of outer vehicle body parts, application of paints, and preparation of vehicles and related components for repair and refinishing.

Tuition **\$4,088**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$3,057

Automotive Service Technology 24 Month Program

Obtain the skills of an entry-level technician in the automotive industry through hands-on practical experience in maintaining, troubleshooting, replacing and repairing systems, and inspecting and overhauling engines and transmissions.

Tuition **\$5,256**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$5,846

Building Construction Technologies 12 Month Program

Curriculum includes the use and operation of basic hand tools, safety issues, building codes and regulations, and development of carpentry, cabinet installation, masonry, roofing, plumbing, air conditioning, heating, and electrical skills.

Tuition **\$3,066**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$678

Child Care Center Operations* 45 Hour Program

Learn how to operate a day care center by developing competencies required for the Florida Child Care and Education Administrator Credential.

Commercial Class B Driving* 1.5 Month Program

The mission of this program is to prepare students for employment as Florida Class B License Truck Drivers.

Tuition **\$438**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$464 **

Commercial Foods & Culinary Arts* 13.5 Month Program

Prepare for a variety of positions in the culinary industry including dining room operations, beverage management, steward, utility cook, breakfast cook, line cook, garde manger, and pastry chef.

Commercial Photography Technology* 18 Month Program

Prepare for a career in the field of commercial photography as a portrait, wedding, industrial photographer, or photo technician in the photographic digital lab industry.

Commercial Vehicle Driving* 3 Month Program

Learn the skills to become a Class A licensed tractor trailer truck driver with emphasis on D.O.T. regulations, cargo handling, trip planning, and vehicle inspection and operations regulations.

Tuition **\$934**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,455 **

Cosmetology 13.5 Month Program

Become a licensed cosmetologist. Learn about shampoos, rinses, scalp treatments, hair styling, hair cutting, facials, manicures, and salon management.

Tuition **\$3,504**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,557

Dental Assisting* 14 Month Program

Train to be the dentist's "Right-hand Person" through the study of basic dental office procedures, dental terminology, patient information and assessment, oral health, preventive dentistry, dental materials, and dental laboratory skills.

Tuition **\$3,591**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,670

Digital Video Production 18 Month Program

Prepare for employment in the digital video production industry as an audio/video equipment technician, video/television camera operator, video editor, multimedia artist or broadcast technician.

Tuition **\$4,380**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$934

Drafting 18 Month Program

Train to be an architectural, civil, mechanical or structural drafter. Learn to use AutoCAD, AutoCAD Civil 3D, AutoCAD Inventor, Revit, and Revit Structural.

Tuition **\$4,380**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,496

Early Childhood Education* 9 Month Program

Graduates earn an Early Childhood Professional Certificate (ECPC) and are prepared to be in charge of children in group care.

Tuition **\$1,752**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$298

Electricity 14 Month Program

Prepare for employment as an electrician. Content includes basic safety and code, circuits, diagramming, all phases of residential wiring circuits and installation, pipe bending, transformers, motor controls, and data and fiber cabling.

Tuition **\$3,504**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,491

Jewelry Making & Repair 18 Month Program

Prepare for a career as a stone setter, jewelry designer/fabricator, jewelry repairer, or certified jeweler. Laboratory activities include instruction in the use of equipment, tools, materials, and processes found in the jewelry industry.

Tuition **\$4,818**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,352

Landscape Management* 11 Month Program

Learn plant growth and reproduction, plant problems, pest management, fertilizers, irrigation, pruning, plant identification and safe use of tools and equipment.

Tuition **\$2,628**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$461

Medical Coder/Biller* 12 Month Program

Learn medical terminology, use of ICD and CPT coding systems, and an understanding of medical billing.

Tuition **\$2,920**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$2,579

Medical Record Transcribing* 14 Month Program

Students will learn the operation of word processing and transcription equipment and achieve basic skills in the transcription of various medical documents.

Tuition **\$3,504**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$2,390

Patient Care Assistant 3 Month Program

This fast-paced program prepares students for employment as a Nursing Assistant, Home Health Aide and/or Patient Care Assistant. Students may continue training in Practical Nursing.

Tuition **\$847**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$625 **

Pharmacy Technician* 12 Month Program

Obtain the certification required by the State of Florida through a curriculum including pharmaceutical chemistry and preparations, unit dose packaging, and intravenous admixture.

Tuition **\$3,066**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,223

Plumbing Technology 11.5 Month Program

Prepare for employment in the plumbing industry as a plumber's helper, or residential or commercial plumber through hands-on learning and application.

Tuition **\$2,803**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,653

Practical Nursing* 15.5 Month Program

Train in the administration of treatments and medication in the care of the ill while gaining the skills and knowledge to successfully pass the State Licensing Exam and become a Licensed Practical Nurse.

Tuition **\$3,942**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$3,405

Public Works* 5 Month Program

Prepare for employment in wastewater systems, plant operations and park maintenance. Content includes procurement of a Class B driver's license.

Tuition **\$1,314**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$454 **

School Age Certification Training* 120 Hour Program

Students will understand and demonstrate the following elements of the child care industry: physical and intellectual competence, family involvement, developmentally appropriate practices for school age children, and program management.

Tuition **\$350**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$146 **

Surgical Technology* 13.5 Month Program

Combine the knowledge of human anatomy, instrumentation and surgical patient care to facilitate the surgeon's performance of invasive and diagnostic procedures.

Tuition **\$3,884**/Approximate cost for additional fees, books, equipment during the course of the program \$1,761

Getting Started at Pinellas Technical College

1. Take the TABE (Test of Adult Basic Education).
2. Meet with a counselor to discuss your TABE results, program interests and requirements.
3. You may visit your program(s) of interest.
4. Apply for Financial Aid.
5. Complete registration form, confirm your residency status, and pay for class.
