

Participation is available to all 3rd – 5th graders. A qualifying test will be given Friday, February 10th, in the library. Students must have read five of the Battle of the Books titles to take the qualifying test and also pass the reading counts tests. Test questions are based on plots, settings and characters. Teams will be chosen from 3rd – 5th grade classes based on scores from the qualifying test.

We will meet during lunches (Wednesdays -3rd grade) and (Thursdays - 4th and 5th grade)



Artsonia Update:

Thank you to everyone who has already registered your student to allow access to their art gallery page on Artsonia. We currently have 80% of our students registered. If you would like to register your student and do not have their username, please let me know and I can send the information home with your student artist.

Artistic Happenings:

Kindergarten and First grade students just finished learning about John Ringling the circus owner and art collector and created their own circus clown faces in art. We are currently working on learning a variety of patterns to use in our art while creating a valentine collage.

Second grade students just finished a portrait drawing lesson. Ask your student to see their portrait folder. We saw a lot of growth from a beginning portrait to a portrait that was drawn after the lessons! We will begin learning about the artist Pablo Picasso next and how he "rearranged" the portrait in a style called Cubism.

Third grade students are finishing a Pop art painting using intermediate colors. We will get an introduction to printmaking next by creating a collograph print.

Fourth grade students have been using an exciting new art supply called a Gelli plate to create mono prints. We printed textures in different colors, used a stencil to create a two color print and then modified our prints.

Fifth grade students are working on an advanced printmaking technique called reduction printing where they are creating an image out of styrofoam that will be reduced and reprinted several times to create a print with at least three colors in their image.

Kindergarten and First Grade:

We are learning simple songs with games. If you want to know a way to help your child grow musically, sing to them and sing with them. Most of the children know how to use their singing voices. I am trying to help all children find their singing voice.

2nd thru 5th grades are "warming up" their musical minds with the "meaningful movement" book written by David Frego and Marla Butke. The book is a music teacher's guide to Dalcroze Eurhythmics. I discovered this amazing book while attending FMEA in Tampa a few weeks ago.

Second Grade and Fourth Grade:

Both grades are learning a song and game from Jerusalem called, "A Qua Qua." It's fascinating to see the differences between both grade levels as they play the game.

Third Grade:

Thank you for helping to remind your child to put their Recorder in their backpack when they finish practicing at home. Help your child practice with Odogy.com. There are apps on tablets/ipads you might want to research for your children to practice with.

Fifth Grade:

We have been working on Ukulele chords and music in class. Most of us are comfortable playing and singing at the same time. Soon we will be preparing to see the Florida Orchestra at Ruth Eckerd Hall. The concert is in May.

Chorus:

The kids are working hard on singing well. The musical lasts about 9 minutes. I expect those 9 minutes to be jam packed with energy! Our show will be on April 11th, the Night of the Arts.
