Please save the following dates on your calendars if your child is able to participate in upcoming activities and performances. We plan to participate in the **Dunedin Highland Games March (Parade) on Friday, March 27th at 6:30 PM**. We will meet downtown in Pioneer Park at 6PM. The girls can wear any tartan or plaid skirt for the parade; boys may wear kilts or pants. Dancers may wear a white blouse or solid white top, knee socks and sneakers.

We have been invited to perform in the **Opening Ceremonies at the Dunedin Highland Games on Saturday, March 28th around noon** (near the Dunedin Community Center). Dancers will meet at the dance competition venue at 11:30 AM, which is the wooden stage overlooking the duck pond.

Many students have expressed interest in competing in the Highland Dancing competition at the Dunedin Highland Games. First, dancers must register with the South East Federation of United States Teachers and Adjudicators, which entails mailing a form, photo and check (fees range from \$10-\$25, depending on category and age). Then, parents must send in a Highland Games competition registration form. I have forms printed out and can help with the process. Extra classes to prep for the competition are also available outside of school for those interested. 😊
