#### Palm Harbor Middle School counselor takes top honor

#### Flu shot rescheduling

A number of dates are being rescheduled due to an unexpected delay in the manufacturing and shipping of the flu vaccine. Flu season in Florida is normally December through February, so there should be adequate time to receive the vaccine at school sites. Humana covered members still have the option to go to a network pharmacy and receive the flu vaccine free under their health plans. Health & Wellness has received a small supply and will be able to provide flu shots at the locations that were originally scheduled for Tuesday, Oct. 14, and Wednesday, Oct. 15.
