

# It is never too late to Get your High School Diploma

Pinellas County Schools values the importance of continued education and wants to support you in the process of obtaining your GED by matching the funds required for all course work and testing costs.

## How much will it cost?

- \$15 for one term of classes (4 months)
- \$64 for full battery GED test (4 tests)

## When and where do I go for classes?

There are multiple locations around the district

- Flexible hours from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Optimal schedule is two-three times per week
- Attend class with instructor or sign up for online classes
- See your site-based Professional Education Facilitator (PEF) for a complete list of locations and classes

## How long will it take?

- Varies from person to person
- Take pretest to determine strengths and areas of need
- Make take a few weeks, few months or longer.

## How do I register for component points?

- Login to Moodle LMS and **enter 8506061N** or type **ged** in the search box
- Click enroll and take the training assessment survey after you complete the GED

## What else do I need to know?

- You must be a Florida resident for at least one year
- You must be an employee of Pinellas County Schools, family members do not qualify
- Free GED Ready Practice Test vouchers will be available
- Hours of preparation can be used for Certificate of Distinction I or II
- GED test is taken on computer at a testing lab located at either pTEC campus
- Reduced GED exam fees available.
