

## **Date for District Application Acceptance Period**

Beginning Jan.4, the high school application period starts on the PCSB website. Parents and students will be able to start applying to the high schools they would like to attend for the 2017-18 school year. The application period closes Jan.13.



To apply to a school, you or your parent must have a Portal user ID and password. Your parent must go to reservation.pcsb.org and log on to the Student Reservation System.

You will get your acceptance invitation(s) from February 8-15 on the Student Reservation System. If you don't accept the invitation within this time period, your application becomes invalid.

If you don't like the program you got into, or missed the application deadline for the school you want, a late application period begins March 22. Most seats for the bigger programs may be filled by then, so apply early.

If you need help with the application process, the district has scheduled three Application Assistance Nights, which are on Jan. 5, 11, and 12. You can also visit pcsb.org/choice for more help.
