- Buses depart promptly at 5:00 p.m. from ELHS
- Buses leave Grad Bash at 2:00 a.m. to return to ELHS
- Buses arrive back at school approx. 3:30 a.m. on 4/25

GRAD BASH ticket sales

- The cost of transportation and admission is \$115. Cash (exact change only), checks, and money orders accepted
- Students who have **pre-signed up** with Mrs. Dorrier or Mrs. Hynes will have the opportunity to purchase Feb. 5&6 in the cafeteria at lunch or Feb. 9&10 in Mrs. Hynes room 9209 at lunch.
- Any remaining Seats will be open for sale to any Senior Feb. 11 -13 in Mrs. Hynes room 9209 at lunch
- We have 3 buses with 144 spots. Once all buses are filled, no more tickets will be sold.
- No ticket will be sold without the completed mandatory <u>Pinellas County Field Trip Permission Form</u>
- All students must have parent/guardian signatures, even those who are 18 years of age.
- No actual tickets are given until students are on the buses going to the event
- Bring photo I.D. to the event.
- Tickets are non-refundable.

GRAD BASH bus sign-up

- Students must ride a chartered bus with the rest of the group. No private cars are permitted.
- Students must sign up for a bus when they purchase a ticket.
- Students who do not sign up for a bus will be randomly assigned.
- Students may not change their bus assignment once they sign up.
- Students who purchase someone else's ticket (see GRAD BASH TICKET TRANSFERS) must take that person's place on the original bus assignment.

GRAD BASH ticket transfers, through Mrs. Hynes or Mrs. Dorrier

- Students who wish to sell their Grad Bash ticket to another ELHS senior:
 - The deadline for transfers is April 23, 2015 (the day before the event) by the end of the school day.
 - o Potential sellers are responsible for finding another ELHS senior who wants to buy a ticket.
 - Students who buy someone else's ticket must submit the appropriate paperwork to Mrs. Hynes or Mrs. Dorrier when the ticket is transferred.
 - Buyer and seller must go together to see Mrs. Hynes or Mrs. Dorrier.
 - The exact ticket price must be exchanged in the presence of Mrs. Hynes or Mrs. Dorrier and a document must be signed by both parties.
 - Students who purchase someone else's ticket must take that person's place on their original bus assignment.
 - Tickets cannot be transferred without following this procedure.

Grad Bash Dress code

In addition to Pinellas County School Dress Code, Universal Studios has the following rules:

- Acceptable attire for Girls
 - o Dresses, skirts, capris or Bermuda shorts, no shorter than mid-thigh
 - Casual pants (including jeans)
 - Casual blouses and tops with sleeves at least three inches wide
 - Comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots and flip-flops)
 - Purses no larger than 8.5" x 5.5"
 - Cameras and cell phones

- Pro/College T-shirts and collared shirts (no jerseys)
- Acceptable attire for Guys
 - Casual pants or shorts (including khakis and jeans), secured at waist
 - Shirts with sleeves (golf/polo, dress and T-shirts with sleeves), sport jackets and dress suits
 - Comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress shoes, boots and flip-flops)
 - Cameras and cell phones
 - Pro/College T-shirts and collared shirts (no jerseys)
- Unacceptable Attire*
 - Clothing affiliated with any school, sports team, group, club, etc.
 (ex: letterman jackets, clothing with school logos, etc.)
 - o Gang paraphernalia, jewelry, tattoos, clothing or other insignias of any kind
 - Clothing or accessories with area codes
 - Visible undergarments
 - Clothing with visible tears, holes, and shredding
 - Belts, wallet chains, or jewelry of any kind containing spikes
 - Extremely revealing clothing including: bathing suit tops, bottoms, or see-through clothing of any kind
 - Any clothing deemed inappropriate at a school function
 - Guys may not wear tank tops or undershirts
 - Clothing with language or graphics that are obscene, offensive or suggestive of sexual, vulgar, drug, alcohol, or tobacco-related messaging
 - Hats and other head attire
 - All backpacks, briefcases, hip packs, camera bags, tote bags, and oversized purses larger than 8.5"
 x 11"
 - o Weapons, knives, laser pointers, and chemical irritants of any kind
 - Over-the-counter medications; tobacco or tobacco related products such as lighters, matches, pipes, etc.;
 - and alcohol or any controlled substance
 - Any containers with fluids of any kind; this includes water, any drinks and perfumes
 - Aerosol cans/bottles of any type
 - o Guys and girls may not wear basketball shorts of any kind
 - Girls may not wear tube tops, tube top dresses, one-shoulder shirts or any off the shoulder dresses of any kind
