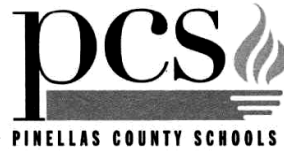

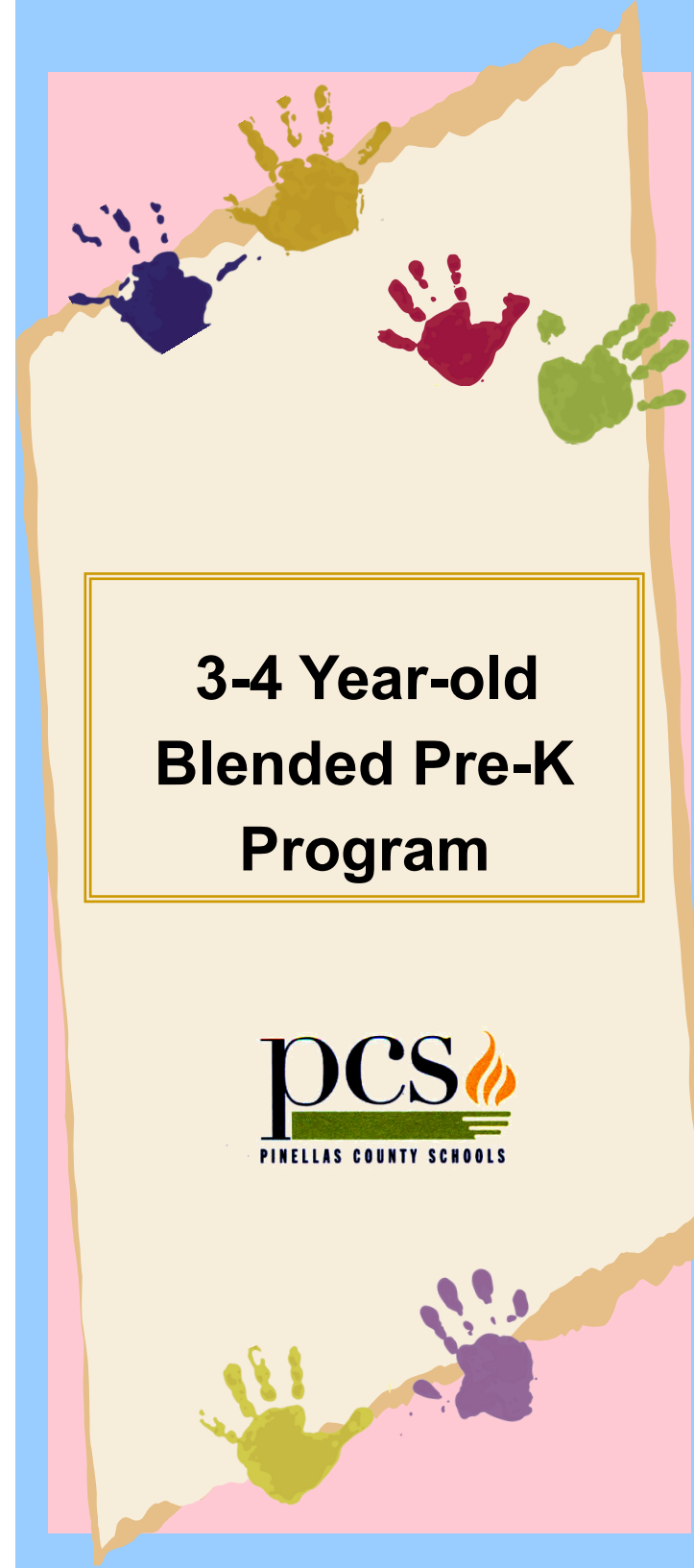

The Exceptional Student Education
Pre-Kindergarten Program
Blended Classes for
3-4 year-olds

Instruction, activities, interactions

The program includes developmentally appropriate activities in literacy, language, science, social studies, math, health and safety, art and music.

Opportunities will be provided for social and physical development through circle time, choice time, dramatic play, and playground activities.

Who, when, and where

Three-year-olds must turn 3 on or before Sept. 1, 2009. Four-year-olds who will turn 5 before Sept. 1, 2010 are not eligible for the 3-4 year-old class (these students are eligible for the VPK program).

Classes will be located at selected Pinellas County schools. These selected locations have other pre-kindergarten exceptional education classes.

The schedule of operation will follow the 10 month school student calendar. The classes will not be open during preschool, post school, inservice and professional education days.

Tuition Fees

The weekly fee is \$75.

Title I Schools – Children who qualify for free and/or reduced lunch **and** attend the 3-4 year old Pre-K at a Title I school will not be charged a fee.

Guidelines for Attendance

Each child's safety is a priority for every class and all staff.

Each school will provide parents with specific directions for parking.

Children must be signed in at arrival and signed out at dismissal. Only those persons designated on the child's identification record and enrollment form are allowed to pick up the child.

Staff will encourage children to behave appropriately by providing well planned age-appropriate activities and rules. If the child becomes a danger to himself or others immediate dismissal from the program will be required.

If there are concerns about the child's development, a referral for screening by an evaluation team may be discussed and considered.

Registration

In order to register your child the following information and forms are required:

- Health insurance proof (copy)
- Birth certificate (copy)
- HRS shot records (date not expired)
- Physical (dated within the last year)
- Proof of residence (copy of electric, cable, water bill)
- Home Language Survey
- Social Security Card (copy requested but not mandatory)
- Lunch Application (required for Title I schools, otherwise optional)

Pick up a registration packet at one of the elementary schools where a blended 3-4 year-old program is located.

To register your child, complete the forms in the registration packet and turn the required forms in to the school office staff.

When you return the registration packet, you will receive the Parent Handbook with the information you'll need about the program.
