If your child is between the ages of 4 to 12 and has experienced a trauma, he or she may qualify to receive therapy through a research study.

The purpose of this research study is to develop and test a child trauma treatment that's easy to manage for parents and kids while being effective in helping your child.

Examples of traumas:

□ Disasters	☐ Serious accidents, such as car wrecks		
□ Sexual abuse	☐ Being involved in a crime such as robbery		
Physical abuse	□ Death of someone close		
□ Domestic violence	 Seeing someone get hurt really badly 		
$\hfill \square$ Serious illness or very frightening	medical experience		
These types of traumatic events m	nay cause children to have posttraumatic stress		
symptoms such as:			
□ Irritable, angry and has temper	tantrums Difficulty sleeping and/or nightmares		

☐ Stomach aches and/or headaches ☐ Looks less happy and is less loving

□ Plays less than before□ More jumpy and scared□ Gets very upset if something happens that reminds them of the trauma

☐ More aggressive (fighting, hitting, biting, shoving)

All children in this study will receive therapy. Compensation will be provided for completing assessments. Parents and children from any state or county may participate. In Hillsborough County call the Crisis Center of Tampa Bay at 813-264-9955
