AMS Dress for Success Expectations

All Azalea Black Knights, staff, and students are required to meet uniform and dress code standards every day. The following is the Dress Code Policy for students at Azalea Middle School and will be enforced per the School Board Policy.

On any given day, students are permitted to wear:

- 1) <u>Polos and Dress Shirts</u>: All shirts must be solid in color. Only black, white, grey, gold and yellow shirts are allowed. They must fit neatly and extend below the waistline.
- 2) <u>Azalea Middle School Shirts</u>: Only school-approved AMS Spirit and Club t-shirts are allowed. They must fit neatly and extend below the waistline. <u>No other t-shirts, including plain t-shirts, are permitted on campus.</u>
- 3) <u>Sweatshirts, Sweaters and Jackets</u>: All outerwear must be solid in color. Only black, white, grey, gold and yellow outerwear is allowed. They must fit neatly and extend below the waistline. <u>Outerwear with a hood is not permitted on campus.</u>
- 4) <u>Pants</u>: All bottoms must be solid in color. Only black and khaki pants are allowed. They must be neat in appearance (no tears or rips) and worn at the waist with no exposed skin or underwear. <u>Athletic pants</u>, sweatpants, yoga pants, joggers, leggings, tights and form-fitting bottoms are not permitted on campus.
- 5) <u>Shorts</u>: All bottoms must be solid in color. Only black and khaki shorts are allowed. They must be knee length at minimum. <u>Skirts</u>, athletic shorts, biker shorts, yoga shorts, compression shorts and form-fitting bottoms are not permitted on campus.
- 6) <u>Footwear</u>: All footwear must be safe and appropriate. Shoes must have a heel strap or closed back. <u>Crocs</u>, slides and flip flops are not permitted on campus.
