Countryside High School Senior Prom Guidelines/Expectations

*The Countryside High School Senior Prom will be held on April 17th, 2020, 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.
at the Safety Harbor Spa and Resort - Safety Harbor, Florida.*

*Cost of ticket includes: entrance to event, dinner and dessert, photo booth pictures,
as well a souvenir prom t-shirt*.*

Purchase of a prom ticket constitutes your agreement to abide by the following guidelines/expectations.

Tickets

- To purchase tickets, you must be an 11th or 12th grader. All guests must fulfill any and all financial obligations. You may only buy two tickets: one for you and one for your guest.
- What to bring: This form signed, and a current photo I.D. When buying a ticket for a guest, you must also present a copy of their current photo I.D. (PCS school I.D. card, driver's license, state I.D. card). The copies will be kept on record and must be clear, unmarked, and easy to read.
- Tickets must be purchased with **CASH ONLY. NO CHECKS.**
- Tickets will be sold as follows during both lunches and after school (1:55-2:25)
 - **Tickets will be sold on March 10th, March 13th, March 24th and March 27th for \$60.00**
 - **Tickets will be sold on March 31st, April 3rd, April 7th, and April 9th for \$70.00.**
 - **Tickets will be sold ALL DAY during Prom Court Elections on April 8th for \$70.00**
 - **The week of Prom: Monday, April 13th through Thursday, April 16th the tickets will be sold for \$80.00**
 - **Please do your best to purchase your ticket PRIOR TO FRIDAY, APRIL 17TH. If you are buying your ticket at the door it will at the price of \$100.**

Guests

- Guests must be at least a high school freshman and must be under the age of 21. *(The age 21 limit does not apply to current Countryside High juniors or seniors.)*
- Students, who are currently suspended, expelled or attending a disciplinary alternative school cannot attend prom. Early graduates may attend as guests only, and must adhere to prom guidelines, policies and PCSB rules.
- If your guest changes, you must change the guest name with Mrs. Gray or Mrs. DeRosa by 2:25 p.m. on April 17, 2020. You must show your student I.D. and copy of new guest's I.D./license. (If you change your guest, you will not get another gift. It is your responsibility to personally exchange your gift with your new guest.)
- You may not swap or sell tickets. Only the student and the registered guest of those tickets will be admitted to prom.
- YOU MUST PRESENT THESE ITEMS FOR ADMISSION TO PROM: your tickets (you will not be able to enter without it) your I.D. and your guest's I.D.
- NO REFUNDS, on prom tickets will be given for any reason.

** The order of prom shirt sizes is preset and no additional shirts will be ordered. If you have a particular size you would like, be sure to buy your prom ticket early; only 350 are available.*

Attire and Conduct (list not inclusive)

- Prom is a formal dress occasion. You will not be admitted to the prom unless you are dressed properly. Dresses should be of appropriate length, not above the thigh, nothing see through, no low plunging necklines. No shorts. No jeans, pants should be formal, khakis are allowed. Dress shirts should have a collar. Formal attire means “dressed up”. **No masks allowed.
- Dancing must remain appropriate to a school environment. Suggestive or dangerous dancing will be stopped and those participating may be removed from the premises.
- Students are responsible for the behavior of any invited guest.
- Once admitted to the prom, you will not be allowed to leave and re-enter. THIS INCLUDES GOING TO YOUR CAR.
- Students may not enter off-limit areas of the prom venue.
- Prom is a school function, alcohol, Tabaco, nicotine, drugs, or smoking from any product/device are not permitted. Violators will be released to parents and school consequences will apply.
- Parent(s) and their student assumes responsibility for any accident or property damage while attending and traveling to and from prom.
- If a student is asked to leave by a chaperone or venue employee and refuses, the proper legal procedures will be followed.
- All rules and regulations of Countryside High School and Pinellas County Schools will be followed. Violators will be released to parents and school consequences may follow.
- The Safety Harbor Resort and Spa has requested that no students or parents of students book a hotel room or stay in a hotel room at the resort on the night of April 17, 2020. This is a request that was set forth by The Safety Harbor Resort and Spa. Students and parents are kindly asked to adhere to this request
- All personal items such as cell phones, car keys, etc. are YOUR responsibility. Countryside High School and the prom venue are not responsible for lost or stolen personal property.

Return this form in order to purchase your tickets. Also, remember to bring your CHS I.D., cash, and the copy of the CHS I.D. or copy of driver’s license of your guest.
