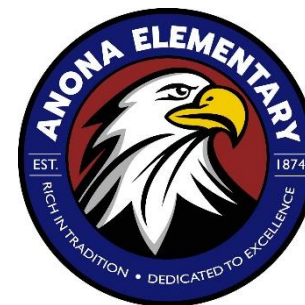
- Have on-going communication with my student's school, including parent-teacher conferences.
