Senior Parking Painting Party

TSHS Senior Student Drivers will have the opportunity to paint/personalize a reserved Senior Parking Spot. The fee to paint a parking spot is \$25, benefiting the Senior Class events and activities. These reserved parking spots are limited to seniors only, and on a first come, first served basis. Students will be asked to come to campus starting July 23rd or thereafter to bring the required documents and have their artwork approved by an administrator.

Senior Lot will open for painting as follows: August 1, 2025 @ 7:30 a.m.

**Additional time will be made available for students to finish their design.*

A SENIOR PARKING DESIGN REQUEST FORM MUST BE APPROVED BY AN ADMINISTRATOR on or before July 31, 2025.

GUIDELINES:

- Reserved spots **MUST** have some indication that it is a reserved spot. Your design can be simple and take up less than the whole spot, but you must add some personalization so that people know they cannot park in it.
- Designs should comply with school dress code standard (no profanity, drugs, violence, or gang affiliations, etc.)
- Designs **MUST** be painted in Water Based Exterior Latex Paint. Use of any other type of paint will result in the student being fined the cost of removal.
- Designs must leave an approximately 4" unpainted border. Do not paint on/over space lines. Blue Painters Tape is excellent to preserve these borders.
- Students must supply all their own materials (brushes, paint, rollers, tape, etc.) and clean up their work area
