

The U.S. Department of Education has provided grant funding through the **CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund** to Pinellas Technical College to help students with additional education related expenses that may have been incurred due to COVID-19 emergency.

To qualify for this grant under Section 484 of the HEA applicants must:

- be a U.S. citizen or eligible noncitizen;
- present a valid Social Security number;
- document registration with Selective Service (if the student is male);
- have a high school diploma, or GED
- have completed a 19/20 or 20/21 FAFSA Financial Aid Application.
- be currently enrolled as of 3/24/2020 in a traditional or hybrid learning career certificate program. Online exclusive programs, fee support programs and dual enrolled students are not eligible for a grant.

Students who meet ALL the eligibility criteria above, will have a check automatically sent to the mailing address on file with PTC.

Students needing to complete the FAFSA Financial Aid Application should visit **www.fafsa.ed.gov or MystudentAidApp** on your mobile device.

Contact your financial aid office 5 days AFTER your application has been submitted. FAFSA applications must be completed by July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 for a student to be considered for grant.
