Lot 1 – (Primary Lot) is located off 86th Avenue near Bauder Elementary. This lot is locked during school hours. Students who must leave early for appointments must notify the front desk at the time of departure so they can have the lot opened.

Expiration Date:

Lot 2 – is the grass lot in front of Building 4. This lot is designated only for students who participate in Dual Enrollment, On-the-Job Training (OJT) or have an internship. You must have permission to use this lot. This lot is locked during school hours and is opened at 12:30 and secured at 1:30 for safety of our incoming busses. If your car is left in the lot after 1:30, you will have to wait until after 2:30 when we can safely reopen the lot.

The rules are as follows:

Insurance Company:

- 1. Students must have a parking permit to park on school property.
- 2. Parking permits are \$10.00 and are non-refundable.
- 3. Students may not park in faculty designated areas.
- 4. Parking permits will not be issued to students that owe for financial obligations. All fees must be paid prior to registration.
- 5. Parking permits will not be issued to students who have missed 15 days (excused or unexcused) in the 2nd semester of the school year.
- 6. Parking permits are not transferable to another vehicle or person. Parking permits present in a non-registered vehicle will be confiscated with no refund and resold. Students must purchase their OWN permits.
- 7. No student may transport other students during school hours (leaving campus on PTL) unless specific permission has been provided by the parents of both the driver and passenger.
- 8. Speeding, driving recklessly, parking illegally or a violation of any other school policy related to parking/driving will result in the following consequences:
 - $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ Offense Written warning and parent contact
 - 2nd Offense Loss of parking privileges and permit

NOTE- Flagrant offenses may result in the immediate loss of driving privileges and parking permit
