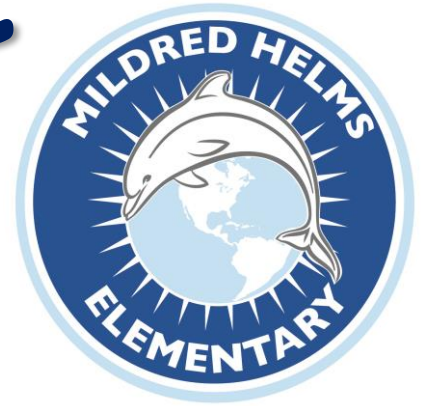




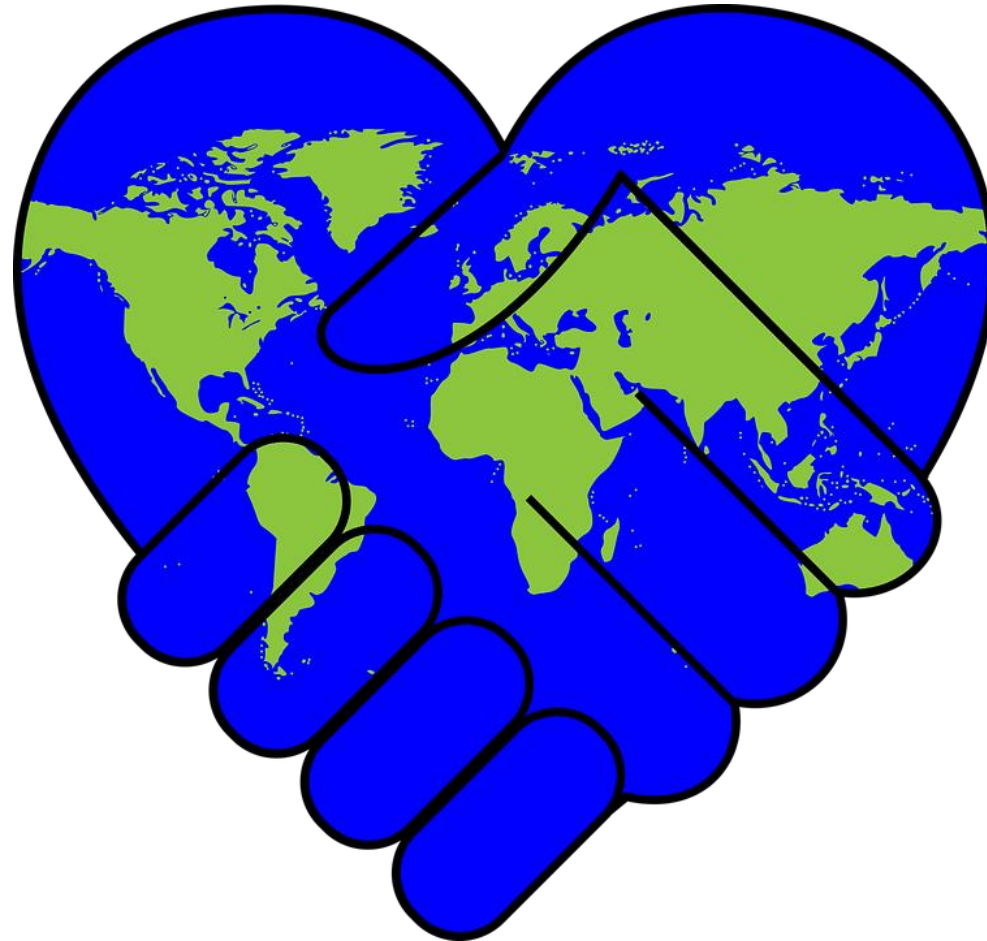

What is the exhibition?

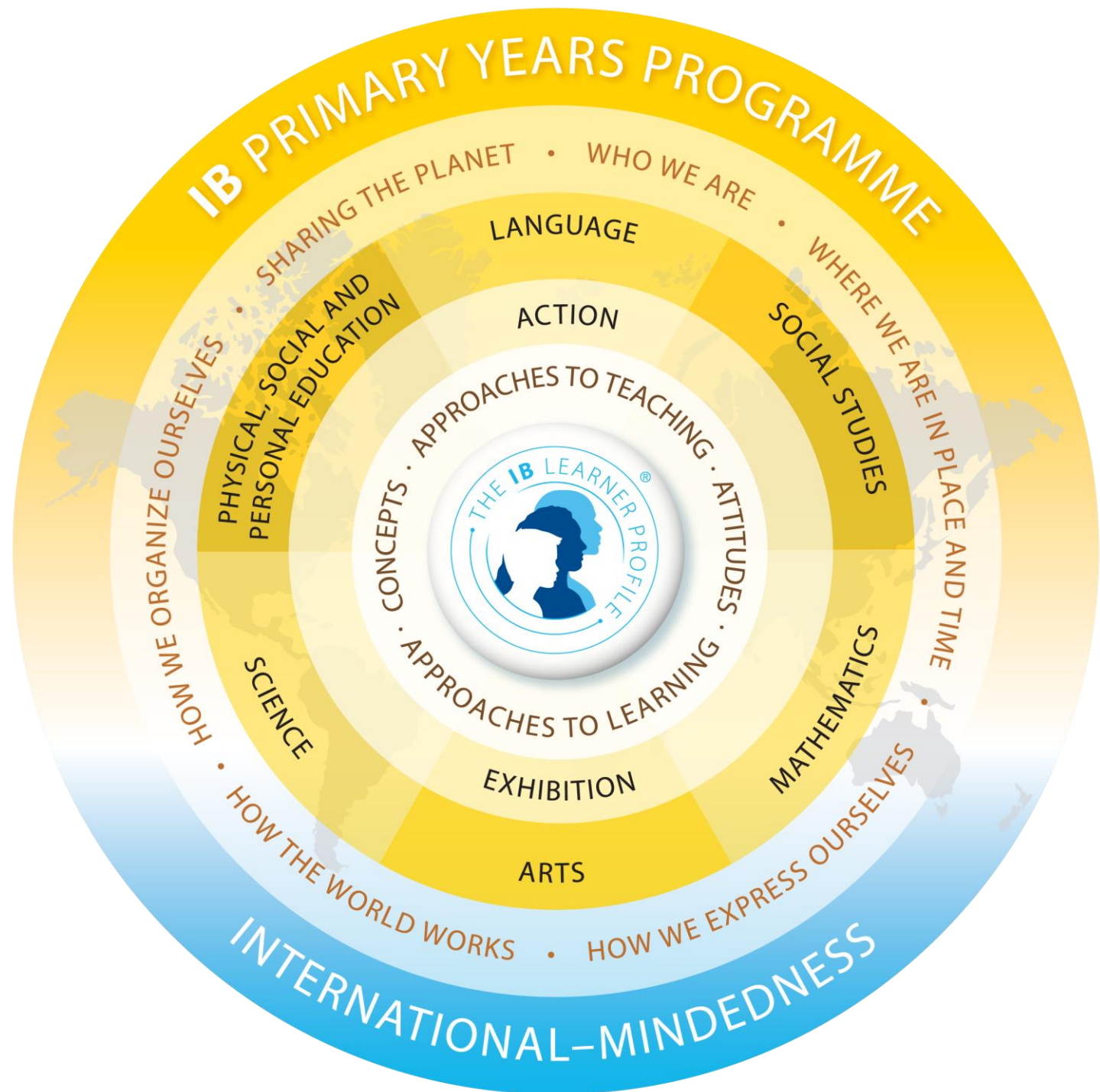
The **culminating, collaborative experience** in the final year of the IB Primary Years Programme.

An authentic **process for students to explore, document, and share their understanding of an issue** or an opportunity of personal significance.

Purpose of the Exhibition

- in-depth, collaborative **inquiry**
- demonstrate **independence & responsibility** for their own learning
- explore multiple **perspectives**
- **apply learning** from their previous years in the PYP
- **reflect** upon their journey through the PYP
- demonstrate how to **take action**
- **unite** the school community
- **celebrate** our learners

Essential Features of the Exhibition



Students will...

- select a **real life issue** or problem
- develop student **questions**
- **work collaboratively**
- understand and develop the attributes of the **IB learner profile**
- understand and demonstrate **knowledge, concepts, skills, and action**
- look at **multiple perspectives**
- **communicate, reflect, and celebrate** learning

Teachers will...

- **guide** the exhibition process
- provide **support**

What can parents do?

- Support and encourage students and teachers
- Stay informed
- Help students get access to resources
- Mentor a group
- Respect student agency
- Celebrate student learning

What do mentors do?

- Provide expertise on issues
- Meet weekly with a collaborative group (not own student!)
- Encourage and support
- Suggest and provide resources
- Ask questions
- Help interpret difficult information
- Help with organization
- Document meetings in exhibition journal
- Reflect on the meeting
