### **Staff Credential Pathways**

Child Care Apprenticeship Program	Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) approved course used to obtain the Florida Staff Credential, <b>Child Care Apprenticeship Certificate</b> (CCAC). This <b>tuition free</b> Program is a cooperative partnership between Pinellas Technical College, the Florida Department of Education and local childcare centers. This program requires students to be employed at a licensed Early Childhood Center and under the direct supervision of someone at their center. Students who successfully complete this program are also eligible to apply for the National CDA. This course is offered evenings at three campuses and distance learning (online). Training includes 144 hours of instruction and 2000 hours of <u>on-the-job</u> <u>training (OJT)</u> .
