# 6. School Improvement Plan (SIP) Goals & Q&A (Principal Lewis)

- The SIP Goals can be viewed on the Jamerson website.
- Goals are developed each summer after reviewing data from PM3 scores, school grades, and other progress measures. Adjustments are made as needed throughout the year.

## Points of Pride:

- Strong gains in ELA for the lowest 25% (L25) students.
- Monitoring and tracking of learning gains, beginning in 3rd grade.
- Noted dip in math L25 performance.
- Grade 3 proficiency decreased slightly with a larger student group.

## • Subgroup Data & Bridging the Gap:

- Jamerson is a "Bridging the Gap" school under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).
- Black students are a focus subgroup; mentorship and data tracking initiatives are in place.
- ESSA goals for Black and ESE students were met this year. Goals reset every 6 years.
- The District is also a Bridging the Gap District

## Action Steps:

- Strengthen Tier 1 instruction through clarity and alignment.
- o Improve student outcomes with tiered interventions.
- Use performance data to inform instruction, including student data chats and trackers.
- Strengthen school culture and behavior systems through PBIS and Conscious Discipline, with emphasis on keeping students in the classroom.
- Continue to deepen engineering focus through magnet program integration, aligning design challenges with standards.
