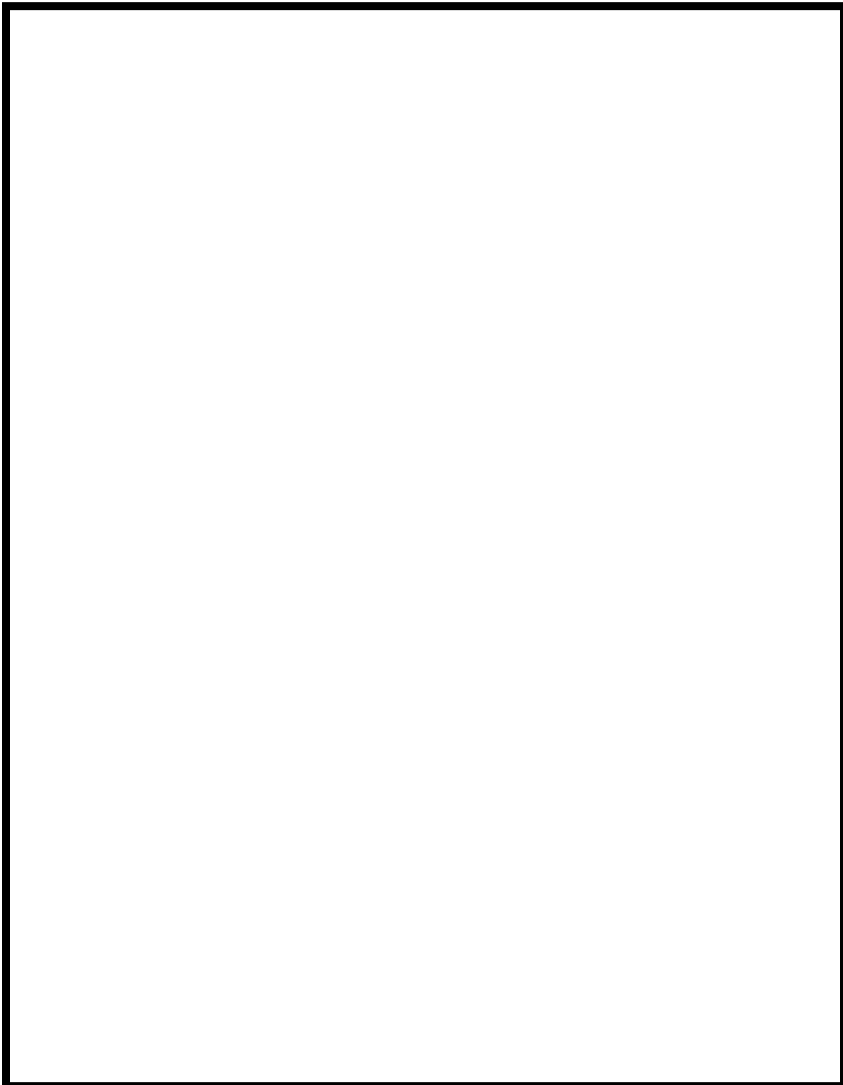

Expectations for the Third Annual Senior PAINT Your PARKING Spot Day

(Please retain this for your review!)

**Senior PAINT Your PARKING Spot will be on
Saturday, August 7, 2021 from 8:00 – 12:00pm weather permitting.**

A Countryside Parking Permit is required (the cost of this is \$5 to the school). Reserving a spot is \$10 (this cost goes to SADD). Price to paint is \$10. The cost includes the school's cost to *repaint* and all other proceeds go to the Senior Class Breakfast. This means a total cost of \$25 – payments can be made on REVTRAK after July 1st.

The upkeep of the space is the responsibility of the student. If the space needs to be repainted during the school year (due to graffiti or any other reason), the student has 48 hours to repaint the space. If the space is not repainted within 48 hours, the space will be painted black and the student will not be permitted to repaint.

Design must be pre-approved and cannot be altered once approved. UPON APPROVAL OF THE DESIGN, Seniors may paint their parking space on Paint Your Parking Day following the guidelines below:

1. You may not paint on or cover the yellow lines or parking space number. Designs must fit the parking space and be 8 inches away from all borders (borders are the front of the space, the yellow lines, and perpendicular distance between the end of the yellow lines). Note: the size and shape of your space may be different than other spaces depending on your assigned spot. The entire space does not HAVE to be filled but it may not go beyond the 8-inch border described above.
2. Designs may not include
 - any vulgarity – explicit or implied,
 - offensive language, pictures, or symbols (including gang symbols/language),
 - double entendre (a word or phrase open to two interpretations, one of which is usually risqué),
 - any names other than the student who “owns” the spot, or
 - any other images/words deemed unacceptable by administration
3. What you need for painting day:
 - Paint – MUST BE INTERIOR LATEX BASED PAINTS ONLY (no striping paint, raised paint, roofing tar, spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint is allowed). LATEX paint in any color once approved in your design.
 - Chalk – to sketch your design prior to painting.
 - A copy of your approved design.
 - Paint brushes, paint rollers, paint trays, painter's tape, stencils, trash bags, and any other painting supplies you would like.
 - Tape measure (or similar) to mark off your 8 inches required for your border
 - Broom for sweeping off your space prior to painting
 - Your own trash bags!
 - Water, snacks, and sunscreen! Tents are always a smart idea, too!
