


#### Cypress Woods Elementary Reader's Workshop

Students are exposed to and get to explore both Fiction and Informational texts through close reading, shared reading, and journaling. During independent and partner reading, students learn various strategies to help them decode words in their "just right books."







#### Cypress Woods Elementary Writer's Workshop

Writer's Workshop builds on the children's strengths, provides meaningful, structured opportunities to write, exposes them to beautiful literature and actively teaches the skills and strategies that writers need.







#### Cypress Woods Elementary Literacy Centers

Literacy Centers provide meaningful reading and writing experiences as students work to apply skills and strategies learned during shared and guided reading lessons.







### Cypress Woods Elementary Mathematics

The children do many hands-on activities involving counting, numeration, measurement, geometry, sorting, adding, subtracting and data collection.

Kindergartners participate in whole-group & small group math lessons daily.







#### Cypress Woods Elementary Science, Social Studies & Health

Kindergartners explore and discover the things and people around them and make connections between their own personal lives and the larger world around them. In Science, our lessons focus on Physical Science, Earth Science, and Life Science. Our Social Studies curriculum includes: seasons, All about Me, families, and important people, dates, and holidays throughout the year. In Health, we learn about healthy behaviors, safety, and our bodies.







# Cypress Woods Elementary Technology Integration

We use technology in so many ways at CWE! Some of the ways technology is implemented throughout the day includes:

- **SmartBoards** these can be used with whole group instruction, involve individual hands-on participation, and it is engaging!
- iPads each classroom has a class ser of iPads which is used for assessments, online reading/math programs, other academic programs, and occasionally during specials (Art, Music, PE)
- Computer Labs students can go 2x per week to use our reading and math programs

### Cypress Woods Elementary Prekindergarten (PreK 3's & VPK)

- PreK 3's and VPK units
- VPK student registration requires a voucher from the Early Learning Coalition (ELC)
- Application window occurred in November
- Late application period begins on February 13th
- 2023-24 Weekly Tuition
  - PreK 3's \$95.00
  - VPK \$65.00 (½ day option for no fee)
  - Registration fee applied to last week tuition

Rising Kindergarten & Summer VPK

#### **Summer VPK...**

 Summer VPK is only for those who did not attend VPK during the school year. The summer program is available at select elementary schools and is a full day program, Monday through Friday and require a VPK voucher.

#### Rising Kindergarten Program...

 Rising Kindergarten is for incoming kindergarten students to sing, play and dance the day away, while they develop literacy skills and prepare for kindergarten success! This program is available at all Summer Bridge sites for 5 hours a day Monday-Thursday for 6 weeks.

# Cypress Woods Elementary Registration Process

- Obtain a username and password to make a reservation in the student reservation system
  - Visit any Pinellas County School
  - Complete username/password request form tonight OR email Kelly Collier, office clerk at <u>collierke@pcsb.org</u> (include picture of driver's license, phone number, and student name)
- Once reservation is made a registration packet needs to be picked up from our front office
  - •Complete packet at home and gather required documents (see booklet)
- Return packet with required documents to the front office to complete the registration process for 2023-2024 school year

**RESERVATION + COMPLETED REGISTRATION = ENROLLMENT FOR 23-24**
