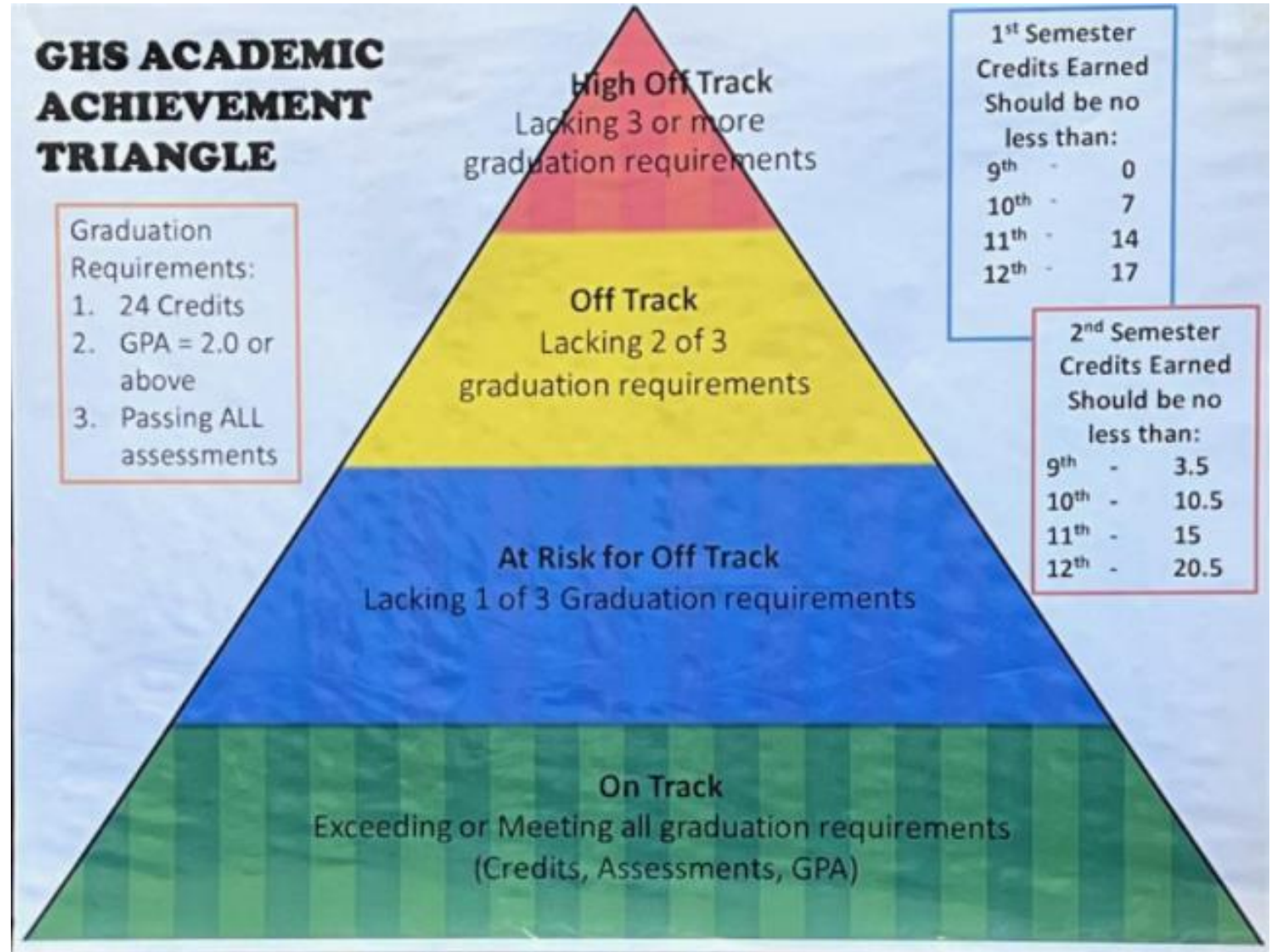

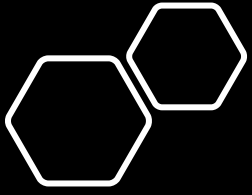

 - Khan Academy – video tutorials for all areas

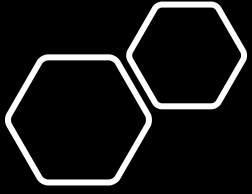




Resources for Reading

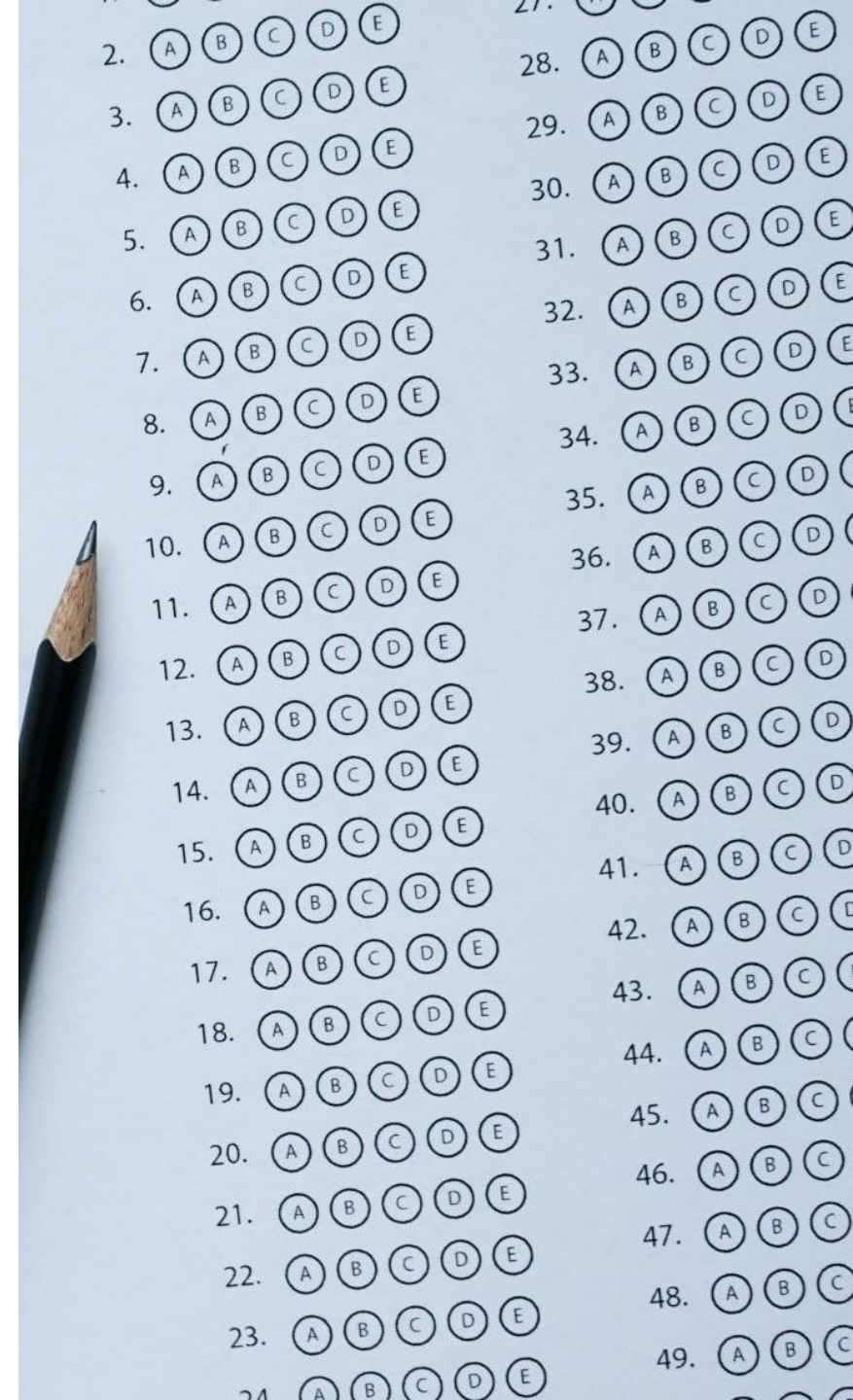

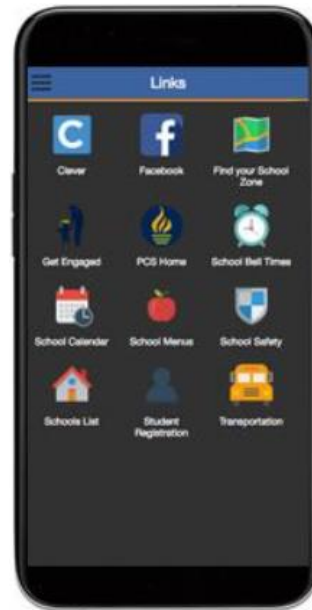
