| Palm Harbor University High School is a high-performing, nationally recognized school that has developed a curriculum to meet the needs of a diverse student population. It offers an innovative University program coupled with two dynamic magnets, the International Baccalaureate Program and the Center for Wellness and Medical Professions. The school focuses upon preparing students for the future while maintaining a safe learning environment that promotes highest student achievement. | PHUHS offers 48 honor courses, 25 advanced placement courses, 44 IB courses, five medical certification courses and five on-campus dual enrollment courses. Students enrolled in an AP class are required to take the AP examination in May. The following AP courses are available: AP 2D Art Design, AP Art History, AP Bio, AP Calc AB, AP Calc BC, AP Capstone Research, AP Capstone Seminar, AP Chemistry, AP Computer Sci Principles, AP Computer Sci Application, AP Drawing, AP English Lang, AP English Lit, AP Environmental Sci, AP European History, AP Human Geography, AP Microeconomics, AP Music Theory, AP Physics 1, AP Psychology, AP Spanish Lang CU, AP Statistics, AP US History, AP US Government/Pol, and AP World History. Our on-site dual enrollment courses available are: Composition 1, Composition 2, Intermediate Algebra, College Algebra, The College Experience. PHUHS also offers a full-diploma IB Program (for IB students only) and a Medical Magnet program (see attached profiles) |
