
WHAT IS WINTERGUARD

Winterguard is the use of flags, sabres, mock rifles, and other equipment, as well as dance and other interpretive movement. Winter color guards can be found in high schools, middle schools, universities, and other independent organizations, some of which are related to drum corps. There are two levels of classification: Independent and Scholastic. Independent groups are self-organized and funded, sometimes they are an extension of a college program. Scholastic ensembles are programs that compete on behalf of their school. For both Independent and Scholastic classes, WGI (Winterguard International) and FFCC Florida federation of Colorguards. offers competitive divisions of A Class, Open Class and World Class. This will allow ensembles to compete and be compared with other groups at a similar skill level. Ensembles in A Class use a beginners skill set, Open Class has an intermediate skill set and World Class an advanced skill set. The Independent World Class has no age limit. Founded in 1977, WGI Sport of the Arts has grown to include nearly 1,000 color guards competing with WGI. Winter Guard now exists in Africa, Belgium, Canada, England, Germany, Holland, Indonesia, Ireland, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, and Thailand and the United States. The FFCC and WGI competitive season begins in January and finishes in April at the Color Guard World Championships.

Director of Dance



THE FEES WE CHARGE FOR THE WINTERGUARD GO TO THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

Guard Instruction, Show Design, 1 Practice Flag Pole and 1 Practice Flag Silk, FFCC Dues (contest/membership fees) + Daytona, WGI Dues (contest/membership fees), Rifle (dependent on year), Show Silks/Props, Body Stocking or Tights, Gloves, Themed Shirt, Supplies (tape, paint, bolts/tips, etc.)

Our fees this year are \$525.00 for the season. If you wish, you may break the fee into three payments, or monthly (Oct-Feb):

THREE PAYMENT PLAN

FIRST PAYMENT DUE AT FIRST PRACTICE- October 5th: \$200

SECOND PAYMENT DUE BY- November 2nd: \$200

FINAL PAYMENT DUE BY- January 11th: \$200

MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN (October thru February only)
FIRST PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE FIRST PRACTICE- October 2nd: \$120
THEN THE FIRST PRACTICE OF EACH MONTH \$120

DISCOUNTED TOTAL IF YOU PAY IN FULL BY THE FIRST PRACTICE- \$500

OTHER COSTS:

UNIFORM: ALL members will be required to buy the uniform (this will be decided after the show design is chosen.) I have asked that this cost be held down as low as possible. We usually pay for these in January (not included in fees.) Typically; \$100-\$120. We order these ASAP. If you son/daughter decides to quit pre-season, you will be financially responsible.
