- Title 1 is the largest federal assistant program for our nation's schools. Federal funds are provided to PCSB who allocates the funds based on percentage of children who are eligible for free/reduced lunch.
- The program serves 99 schools in Pinellas County.
- The goal for Title 1 is that every student achieves high levels of academic proficiency,

SCHOOL-WIDE PLANNING & INPUT

1. Seek input from school, family, and community members to determine how Title 1 Funds are used based on needs assessment.
2. Attend online or in-person meetings to complete surveys to provide input on Title 1 funding.
3. All Title 1 schools must document that parents are involved in the school-wide process.

PARENT'S RIGHT TO KNOW

- Be provided information on your child's level of achievement on assessments in ELA, Writing, Math, and Science
- Request and receive information on the qualifications of your child's teacher and supplemental personnel working with your child.
- Be notified of non-highly qualified or out-of-field teachers at the school.
- Be informed if your child is taught by a non-highly qualified teacher for four or more consecutive weeks.
