SERVICE LEARNING GUIDE

A Guide for Volunteers

WHAT IS SERVICE LEARNING?

• Service Learning connects meaningful service, schoolwork, personal growth, and civic responsibility. It is more than just volunteering; it fuses your academic coursework with a specific community problem.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

• To help you get started, Pinellas County recommends seven steps to have a positive and successful Service Learning experience.

STEP 1: How do you want to help your community? What segment of your community do you want to make a lasting impact on?

<u>STEP 2</u>: Find an agency that matches the issue you care about.

<u>STEP 3</u>: Call the contact person listed for the agency you want to work with and tell them you want to complete a Service Learning project there.

STEP 4: Ask questions!

- What does the organization do?
- Where is it located?
- Where will I be volunteering?
- Are the hours flexible enough so I can complete my project?
- Can you mail me a volunteer description and a brochure about the agency?
- Are there any age qualifications to volunteer?

STEP 5: Arrange a time to meet the volunteer coordinator at the agency.

<u>STEP 6:</u> Have FUN! Commit to your project and keep it!

<u>STEP 7:</u> Get everything signed and keep copies for your records.

BEFORE YOU GET STARTED:

- How much time do you have each week to volunteer at the agency?
- How will you get to the place where you will be volunteering?
- What time of the day do you want to volunteer
- How long can you commit for?
- Is there anything you don't want to or would be afraid to do?

AFTER YOU HAVE STARTED:

- Have you been keeping track of your hours?
- Is your paperwork complete and up-to-date?
- What are you learning as a result of your volunteer time?
- Is there another volunteer opportunity in the agency that you would like to try?
