Throughout the academic year, students will engage in goal-setting experiences designed to support their personal and academic growth. These experiences will be collaborative efforts involving students, family members, instructional staff, and administration. Milestone celebrations will be held throughout the year to recognize progress and achievements.

The goal-setting process is intended to:

- Promote a Growth Mindset
- Provide Clear Focus for Feedback
- Encourage Self-Reflection
- Foster Motivation
- Increase Ownership and Accountability

To support student growth and success, administration will meet weekly with each Level 25 (L25) student to review academic progress and monitor individual goals. These meetings aim to:

- Improve attendance
- Strengthen the student and family connection to the school
- Provide consistent mentoring opportunities
- Celebrate academic progress and success

In addition, administration will provide a framework to extend the student learning day by expanding access to academic and enrichment clubs, as well as extended learning programs. These opportunities are designed to reinforce learning, build skills, and engage students beyond the traditional school day.

Teachers will participate in administratorled Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) throughout the year. These PLCs will focus on progress monitoring, goal setting, and the analysis of student data to drive instructional decisions.

Additionally, teachers will engage in monthly professional development sessions centered on enhancing the student writing experience across all grade levels and content areas.

There will also be an increased emphasis on vertical collaboration and intentional progress monitoring to support and track student learning gains over time.
