NSE Drama Club presents "Willy Wonka & The Chocolate Factory". Come join us after you visit the NSE Art Show!

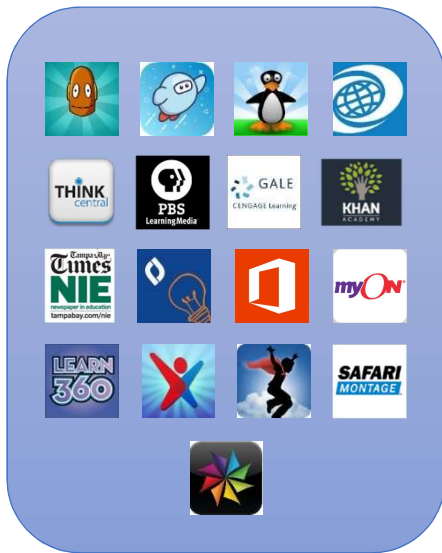
