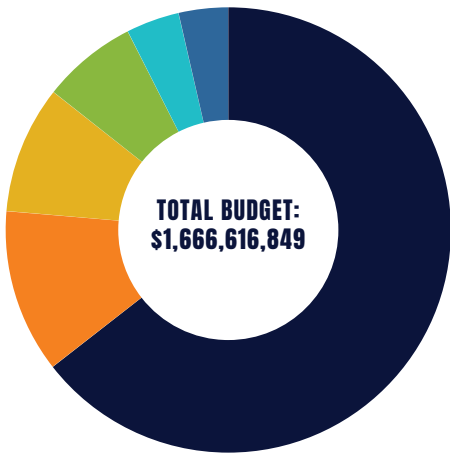

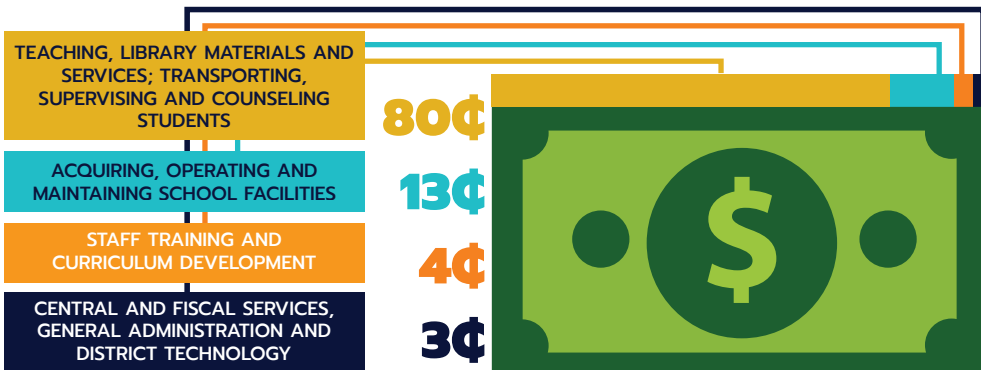

BUDGET BREAKDOWN

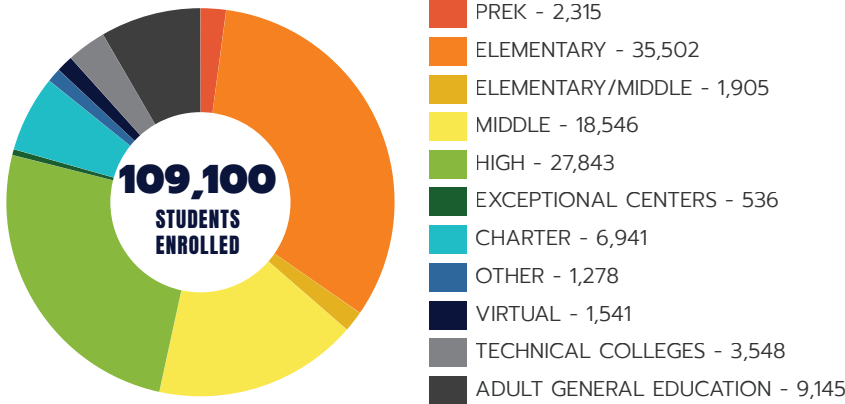
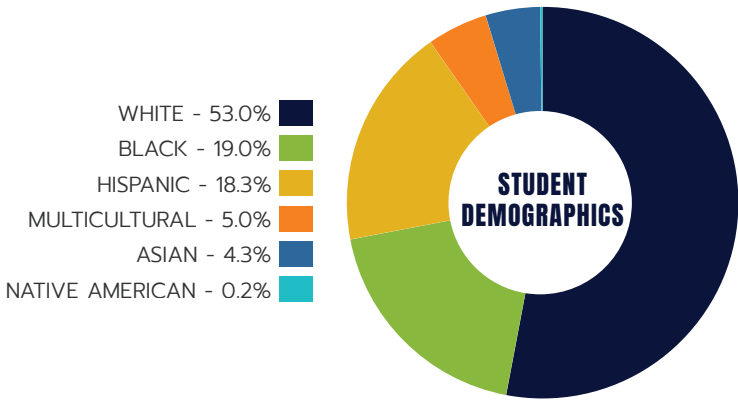

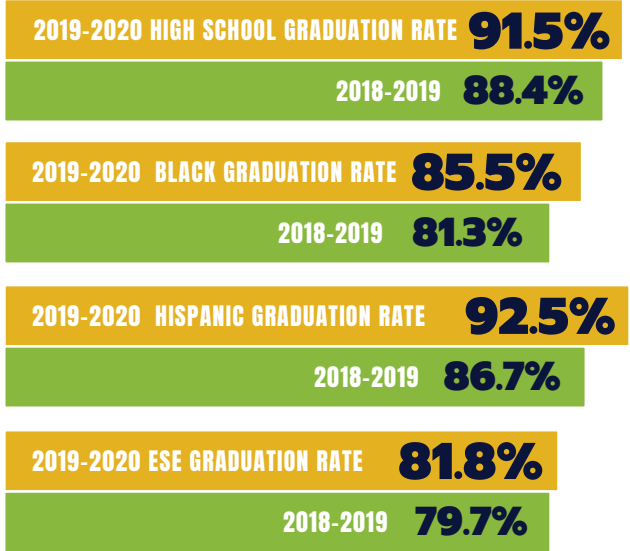

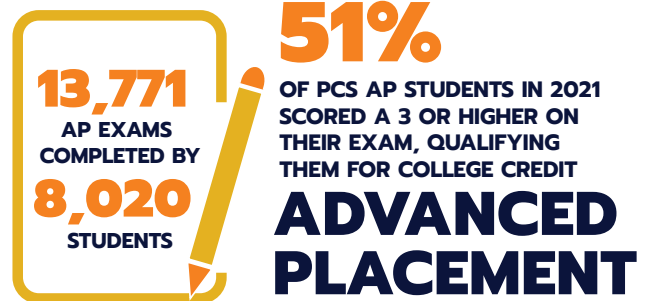

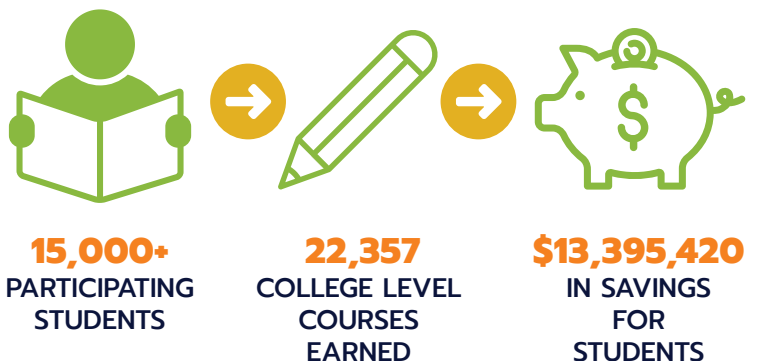
