# STRATEGIC PRIORITY 3 EQUITY WITH EXCELLENCE FOR ALL

## **ALL SUBGROUPS DEMONSTRATED INCREASED PROFICIENCY** ACROSS ALL STATE ASSESSMENTS



Among all student groups, Black students and students with disabilities showed the most improvement in math proficiency, increasing by 6.8 percentage points.



Students with disabilities showed the greatest improvement in reading proficiency, with a 6.9 percentage point increase.



English Learners showed the greatest improvement in overall science proficiency, with an increase of 8.9 percentage points.



Black students showed the most improvement in overall Social Studies proficiency, increasing by 10.1 percentage


