# MTSS: Multi-Tiered System of Supports



Each tier of the MTSS model represents a greater intensity of services and more frequent data collection.

When family—school partnerships are included as part of this process, each subsequent tier also represents greater opportunity for communication and joint problem solving amongst families and educators.

Shared responsibility and participation, or "co-roles", are represented in the pyramid to the left, (much like the tiers of MTSS). Each tier, or "co" role for families and schools requires greater amounts of time, commitment, and contribution on the part of families and educators.

# Flu Season Arrives in Tampa Bay

Hillsborough leads with 10 of the state's 12 outbreaks, including 7 in the past week, health officials say.

Cases are on the rise with school kids especially, with multiple outbreaks noted. The health department is encouraging parents to get their kids vaccinated as soon as possible.

Influenza usually peaks between December and February in Florida, as holiday and snowbird travel begin to pick up. There's a much higher chance of getting the flu around the holidays when people are traveling.

The vaccine won't necessarily prevent the flu, but it will help lessen the symptoms if someone catches the virus. It is safe for anyone 6 months or older and a stronger dosage is recommended for patients 65 or older.

If a person is experiencing severe symptoms, like trouble breathing, high fever, vomiting and general disorientation, they should go to a hospital emergency room. Early and mild symptoms such as a cough, sore throat and congestion, can be treated and diagnosed at an urgent care center.
