## 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR DAP (Magnet) APPLICATION PERIOD

\*\*Attention: Parents of 5th Graders & Incoming Siblings\*\*

The application period for the District Application Programs (magnet & fundamental schools) is here! Specific process guidelines can be found at www.pcsb.org, but here are some highlights:

- Current Perkins Elementary students that intend on remaining at Perkins next year do not need to do anything.
- The entire application and acceptance process is online at www.pcsb.org. Applicants will rank their program choices in order of preference from 1 to 5.
- The application period is January 9th through January 18th. The acceptance period is February 13th through February 22nd. **Invitations that are not accepted, will be forfeited.**
- Siblings of currently enrolled K-4th grade Perkins students, that reside in the same household have SIBLING PRIORITY ENROLLMENT STATUS. However, they still need to submit an application. Please indicate the sibling priority in the system at the time of application and notify our Magnet Secretary, Alyson Ogles, of your priority status request at 727-893-2659. Priority is applied only to the first ranked program selected.
- Students that are currently in 5th grade at Perkins will need to apply for a middle school magnet or fundamental program if they would like to attend a middle school other than their zoned school. Perkins' students are granted priority for acceptance into John Hopkins Middle School Center for International Studies in the Arts and Multimedia Journalism.
