Note: Parents must arrange their student's shadowing and provide transportation. Students are expected to observe the Pinellas County Schools Code of Student Conduct.

Spaces are limited, so make arrangements early. Shadowing students will need to check in at the front office. Shadowing is one on one with a current CJAM student. Drop off time is **7:00 a.m.** in the front office on 54th Avenue S. Pick up time is **1:10 p.m.** Lunch is served in the cafeteria. Lunch is \$2.50, or your student may bring a bag lunch. If your child is currently enrolled in Pinellas County Schools free/reduced meal program, let us know so the cafeteria may be notified. It is the parent's responsibility to contact their student's middle school eighth-grade counselor to let them know that their student will be out for the scheduled shadowing date. The CJAM program will give the student paperwork to return to their middle school counselor for the next day. Shadowing is set up according to each school's discretion.
