STUDENT VIOLATES C.E.L/R.I.S.E POLICY

- 3 Referrals in 1 Quarter or 4th in a school year
- Two Out-of-School Suspensions
- Excessive Tardies
- 1 Referral for a SESIR Incident

MANIFESTATION MEETING

A student with a 504 or IEP will have a meeting to determine if their disability is the reason for the violation of policy. If it is a manifestation, student does not go to MIC. If it isn't a manifestation, student is referred to MIC.

MIC

MIC is held quarterly. The committee and family will discuss the violation, supports needed, and problem-solve on how to avoid violating policy in the future.

MIC DETERMINATION

After the MIC meeting, the committee will discuss parent and student input, review student records, and make a determination on probation or dismissal (if student was previously on probation). If dismissal is proposed, Program Coordinator meets with Principal. If Principal agrees, Area Superintendent is contacted for approval.

NOTIFICATION TO PARENT/STUDENT

Within 24-48 hours of MIC determination meeting, Program Coordinator will contact parent with result and will be given information on probation requirements or dismissal next steps.

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
