- Performing outstanding volunteer work as an individual or with a local company/business.

- Fundraiser or charitable contributor that supports youth/senior programs, animal interests or local nonprofit organizations.
- Demonstrates random acts of kindness.

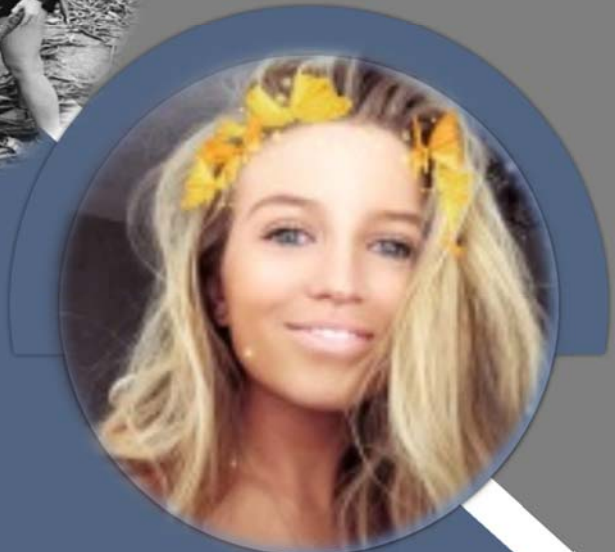


Olivia walked into a room and the light came on. Her glow put the sun to shame.
