Frequently Asked Questions: For Kindergarten Families

1. What are the school hours?

School begins at 8:45am and ends at 2:55pm

2. Is breakfast available? If so, what time?

Breakfast is provided to all of our scholars between 8:15 am and 8:40 am

3. Is there before and/or after care available?

4. How do I receive a parent username and password to make a student reservation?

To obtain a username and password, take a photo id (driver's license, state id, passport, etc.) into any Pinellas County School and ask for one.

5. What if I have been issued a parent username and password but I've forgotten my password?

You can take your photo id (driver's license, state id, passport, etc.) into any Pinellas County School and ask for it to be reset.

6. Why do I need a Parent User ID and Password?

A Parent User ID and Password is used with Focus and the Student Reservation System. This allows parents/guardians to log into Focus to see their student's grades, attendance and other items pertaining to the student.

Parents will use the Student Reservation System to reserve a seat for enrolling a new student for the Next School Year.

7. What do I do once I make my reservation?

Bring the required registration documents listed below to the zoned school to complete the registration process.

- Birth certificate or other proof of identity/age (required)
- Two forms of proof of residency (required)
- Florida Certificate of Immunization (required)
- Physical examination certificate (required)
- Child's Social Security number
- Child's most recent report card
- Recent Individual Education Plan if applicable
