The VISION of the PCS K-12 STEM Department is to increase STEM opportunities for Pinellas County students, preparing them to excel in STEM fields of study, allowing them to meet the challenges of the global society through innovation, collaboration and creative problem solving.

The PCS STEM Academy program will offer your child opportunities to conduct hands-on STEM investigations, learn about the engineering design process, improve team building/leadership skills, explore STEM career pathways and interact with community business partners!

## <u>Deadline to apply</u>: Completed applications due no later than Thursday, September 19, 2019.





#### Who?

We are accepting 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students. We look for students who work hard, have an interest in STEM concepts and will participate for the full 27 weeks. There is no academic performance requirement, however only 20 students can be enrolled into each after-school STEM Academy.

Due to increased demand to participate in this FREE program hosted by the PCS K-12 STEM Department, all students who submit a completed application by September 6 will get an equal chance at enrollment using a the lottery process listed below.

Completed applications will be collected and divided into two piles (female and male). Through the use of random lottery, 10 females and 10 males (as close as possible) will be selected per STEM Academy. If more than 20 students apply, remaining students will be placed on a wait list. ALL families will be notified if their child was selected or placed on the a wait list.

- Primary STEM Academy offerings:
  - √ 2<sup>nd</sup> grade (total of 20 students)
  - ✓ 3<sup>rd</sup> grade (total of 20 students)
- Intermediate STEM Academy offerings:
  - 4th grade (total of 20 students)
  - ✓ 5<sup>th</sup> grade (total of 20 students)

#### When?

This 27-week program will begin during the first week in October 2019 and will continue through the last week in April 2020. Your child's STEM Academy will meet once per week for 60 minutes after school.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> grade STEM Academy at your school will be held on Monday from 2:55pm to 3:55pm.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> grade STEM Academy at your school will be held on Tuesday from 2:55pm to 3:55pm.

The 4th grade STEM Academy at your school will be held on Wednesday from 2:55pm to 3:55pm.

The  $5^{\rm th}$  grade STEM Academy at your school will be held on Thursday from 2:55pm to 3:55pm.

The STEM Academy will be held at your child's school and transportation MUST be provided by the parent/guardian each week. Students will **NOT BE PERMITTED TO WALK/BIKE** home. Please be on time and waiting at the front office gate to pick up your child.

#### How?

Fill out the attached application (page 3) and submit it to your child's classroom teacher who will then give it to Ms. McLendon (the STEM Academy teacher) no later than Thursday, September 9. Please enter information for every area on the application, especially the email section, as this will be used as the main form of communication to receive STEM Academy updates and opportunities.

#### Cost?

The PCS K-12 STEM Department offers the STEM Academy program at your child's school, FREE of charge.

#### What?

During the FREE STEM Academy program, students will conduct hands-on activities related to STEM concepts, explore careers in STEM, and complete a STEM engineering design project. All STEM engineering design projects will be displayed during the annual STEM Expo which will be held on April 25, 2020 at Pinellas Technical College, St. Petersburg campus.

### **Attendance Requirements**

Attendance is a critical component to the success of this program considering the amount of collaborative work completed in teams. Due to the overwhelming interest in the STEM Academy program and the rigor of the planned activities, it is highly suggested that your child tries to attend each session. If your child misses more than 4 unexcused sessions (sick absences will be an exception), they will be removed from the academy and replaced by one of the students on the wait list. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> unexcused absence, the STEM Academy teacher will call or speak with you in person to provide an attendance reminder.

### **Family Involvement**

Later in the year, students enrolled in the STEM Academy program will receive an invitation to attend and present at the annual FREE STEM Expo that will be held on April 25, 2020 at the Pinellas Technical College, St. Petersburg campus. Last year we had more than 3,200 people attend!
