The content includes communication, leadership, human relations and employability skills; safe and efficient work practices; Florida cosmetology law and rules; acquisition of knowledge of the nails specialist and the related chemistry; bacteriology, anatomy and physiology; and development of skills in performing the techniques required in the practice of nails specialist occupations.

Network Support Services*

Learn to troubleshoot complex computer network issues. Prepare to earn certifications in Network+, Certified Entry Network Technician (CCENT), Certified Wireless Network Administrator (CWNA) and Security+.

Pharmacy Technician*

Obtain the certification required by the State of Florida through a curriculum including pharmaceutical chemistry and preparations, unit dose packaging and intravenous admixture.

Phlebotomy*

Pinellas Technical College's Phlebotomy class is designed to prepare students to perform as a professional phlebotomist, primarily drawing blood. After completion of the program a student may sit for the American Medical Technologist's exam to become a Registered Phlebotomy Technician (RPT).

Plumbing

Prepare for employment in the plumbing industry as a plumber's helper, or residential or commercial plumber through hands-on learning and application.

Practical Nursing*

Train in the administration of treatments and medication in the care of the ill while gaining the skills and knowledge to successfully pass the State Licensing Exam and become a Licensed Practical Nurse.
