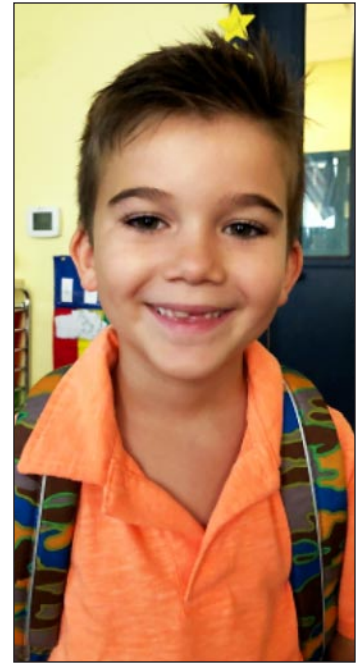

To attend the Center for Gifted Studies at Midtown Academy (not the cultural arts side) students must meet eligibility criteria. For 1st grade, students need a completed formal evaluation with a qualifying IQ score, a copy of their psychological report and be awaiting gifted placement. For 2-5th grades, students must have met all of the state requirements for gifted placement and provide a copy of their Educational Plan.
