## Middle School and High School Dress Code

Tops	<ol> <li>Clothing must cover the body from one armpit across to the other armpit and down to mid-thigh.</li> <li>All tops must have sleeves and cover the entire shoulder.</li> <li>See-through, revealing, or mesh garments must not be worn without appropriate coverage underneath</li> </ol>
Bottoms	<ul> <li>1. Form fitting leotard/spandex type clothing is not allowed unless proper outer garments cover to mid-thigh length or longer.</li> <li>2. Rips, holes, or tears in clothing must be below mid-thigh.</li> </ul>
Footwear	<ul> <li>1. Students must wear shoes that are safe and appropriate for the learning environment. Inappropriate footwear includes, but is not limited to, roller skates, skate shoes, and bedroom slippers.</li> <li>2. No Student will be allowed to wear Crocs.</li> </ul>
Outerwear	<ol> <li>Head gear, including but not limited to, hoods, caps, hats, bandanas, sweatbands and/or sunglasses shall not be worn indoors on campus</li> <li>Hoodie sweatshirts are allowed; however, the hood must remain off the scholar's head at all times.</li> </ol>
