

Dress Code 2023-2024

Any Color Pants/Jeans
Pants MUST be secured at the waist, belts buckled, no underwear exposed.

Must wear a belt.

Shirts

Any color polo style shirts. All shirts MUST have a collar. Tights, Leggings, Spandex, or Gym Wear

Unacceptable

No tights, leggings, or spandex. No gym wear (ex. Gym shorts, tank tops, jerseys, sweat pants, etc.). Pants cannot have gaping holes or tears.



Any Color Shorts (No shorter than 3 inches above the knee), Skirts/Skorts, Carpris, Uniform Dresses or Jeggings with pockets are allowed in solid colors only.



Lealman T-Shirts can be worn any day of the week.

Du-Rags, Scarfs, Hats, Sports Bands, Hoodies

No head wear (ex. Du-Rags, scarfs, hats, bonnets, or sports bands, sunglasses)

> Absolutely No Hoodies/Hooded Jackets

JACKETS/SHOES and other garments:

JACKETS: Jackets ONLY without

hoods!

SHOES: Closed toes shoes (ex: tennis

shoes) or sandals with a strap.

Croc Shoes must always have back strap on or scholar(s) will not be allowed to wear them.

***No Lighters or vapes are allowed in school. No scissors, sharp objects, or lighters attached to articles of clothing



Sleepwear,
Pajamas,
Swimwear,
Boxer Shorts
Plip Flops

No Sleepwear, pajamas, blankets, swimwear or boxer shorts worn as outer garments

Absolutely no slides or flip-flops.



Consequences:

Dress code infractions will be:

- Corrected (parent delivery or clothes closet selection)
- Dress-Code Alert Infraction (Parent call documented in FOCUS and alert infraction provided)
- If a learner refuses to change or removes correction the learner's parent will be called to provide/ bring appropriate clothing, or they will report to P.A.S.S. for the remainder of the day and a Restorative Conference will be **Required**.
- Repeated Infractions will result in a disciplinary referral

1st Offense – Warning, phone call to parent, Clothes Closet 2nd Offense –Dress-Code Alert Infraction 3rd Offense – Referral
