Middle School and High School Dress Code

Tops	 Clothing must cover the body from one armpit across to the other armpit and down to mid-thigh. All tops must have sleeves and cover the entire shoulder. See-through, revealing, or mesh garments must not be worn without appropriate coverage underneath
Bottoms	 1. Form fitting leotard/spandex type clothing is not allowed unless proper outer garments cover to mid-thigh length or longer. 2. Rips, holes, or tears in clothing must be below mid-thigh.
Footwear	 1. Students must wear shoes that are safe and appropriate for the learning environment. Inappropriate footwear includes, but is not limited to, roller skates, skate shoes, and bedroom slippers. 2. No Student will be allowed to wear Crocs.
Outerwear	 Head gear, including but not limited to, hoods, caps, hats, bandanas, sweatbands and/or sunglasses shall not be worn indoors on campus Hoodie sweatshirts are allowed; however, the hood must remain off the scholar's head at all times.
