Our SIP goal for 22-23: We will reduce the percentage of referrals for striking from 43% to 15% as measured in focus in May 2023(the action code of striking was changed to Physical conflict). We currently have 24 referrals for physical contact (striking) a reduction from 39 to 24.

We have four SESIR referrals: School Environment Safety Incident Report. These referral incidents that are against the law or represent serious breaches of the code of student conduct. This includes those incidents considered severe enough to require the involvement of a School Resource Officer (SRO) or incidents to be "Reported to Law Enforcement."
