What courses do I take?

- *Medical Skills and Services* (9th grade): introduction to various health care career clusters.
- Health Science Anatomy & Physiology (10th grade): overview of the human body both structurally and functionally.
- Health Science Foundations (11th grade): emphasis on health care system and associated occupations.
- Exercise Science (12th grade): preparation for the NASM Personal Trainer Certification Exam.
- Courses are offered in a planned sequence to properly prepare students for the NASM exam but are not required to be taken during the recommended grades, with the exception of Exercise Science which is only available to 12th graders.
