

Implement and practice Restorative Practices in grading, behavior management through differentiated lesson planning and delivery through PLC collaboration

Incorporate systematic immediate interventions for each student by reviewing informal, formal and cycle assessments through PLCs by sharing student work, best practices and supporting each student's individual needs

Implement and practice school wide PBIS system- based on Royal Rules and the 5 P's for consistency behavior expectations for all students in all circumstances

Increase the use of WICOR/AVID strategies
-Focused note taking will be utilized to a
method for students to interact and
process their learning in every class across
the curriculum Teachers will routinely and
regularly refer learning and lessons to
student's focused notes

Focus on teaching students at the appropriate level of rigor to be best prepared for FSA/EOC/AICE/SAT/ACT through collaboration and student centered class rooms where students voices are heard

Incorporate and enfuse literacy through a variety of means in each class across he curriculum on a weekly basis where students are engaged in reading complex text and answering and discussing questions at the appropriate level of rigor in which they will be sested
