ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

The Creative Pinellas ArtsCatalyst Grant was created to make it possible for young people in Pinellas County to have great arts and cultural experiences at Pinellas County area local summer camps. You may be eligible for a grant to attend a Summer Camp at a qualified organization if you are a Pinellas County resident between the ages of 5 – 18 whose answer is “Yes, I...” to any of the items on this list:

- Receive a free or reduced-cost school lunch
- Attend a school that is either “transitional” or “transformational” according to the Pinellas County School Board
- Attend a Title I school (check here: <https://www.pcsb.org/Page/10735>)
- Live in a foster or group home
- Am in the custody of the Department of Children and Families
- Receive a financial hardship tuition or scholarship
- Live in East Tarpon Springs, North Greenwood, Highpoint, Lealman Corridor or South St. Petersburg
