

Principal's Message October 15, 2024

Hello Starkey Families,

I was just notified by the School Transportation Safety Coordinator for Pinellas County Public Works, Traffic Engineering that we are NOT able to provide a safe walk path for students on the north OR south side of 86th Avenue. The sidewalks from Starkey Road to 98th Street are hazardous walk paths with no timeframe of reopening. If your child is usually a walker or bike rider, for their safety, they must be car riders. Also, crossing guards will not be posted on 86th Avenue, as it is not safe for them at this time either. Please make sure that your child has a safe way (with a responsible adult) to get to and from school. Please make sure that everyone is patient, as this will create a significant increase in our car circle traffic and wait time. The safety of all our students and families is our utmost priority and we appreciate your support and understanding during this time.
